1. PRODUCT OVERVIEW

This manual provides instructions for the Casio MTP-V001D-1B men's watch. This timepiece features a classic design with a black dial and a durable stainless steel construction, offering reliable timekeeping and water resistance for daily use.

2. SETUP AND INITIAL USE

- 1. Locate the Crown: The crown is the small knob on the right side of the watch case.
- 2. Pull Out the Crown: Gently pull the crown out to the first click position. The second hand will stop.
- 3. **Adjust the Time:** Turn the crown to move the hour and minute hands to the desired time.
- 4. **Push In the Crown:** Once the time is set, push the crown back in to its normal position. The second hand will resume movement.



2.2 Adjusting the Bracelet

The stainless steel bracelet may need adjustment to fit your wrist comfortably. This typically involves removing or adding links. It is recommended to have this procedure performed by a qualified jeweler or watch technician to prevent damage to the bracelet.

To wear the watch, open the clasp, place the watch on your wrist, and secure the clasp. Ensure the watch is snug but not too tight, allowing for comfortable movement.

3. OPERATION

3.1 Basic Timekeeping

The Casio MTP-V001D-1B is an analog watch that displays time using hour, minute, and second hands. Once the time is set, the watch will continuously keep accurate time using its quartz movement.

4. MAINTENANCE

4.1 Water Resistance

This watch is water resistant up to 30 meters (3 ATM). This means it is suitable for everyday use and can withstand splashes or brief immersion in water. It is **not** suitable for swimming, diving, or showering with hot water, as steam can penetrate the seals.

4.2 Battery Replacement

The watch is powered by a single Lithium Metal battery. When the watch stops or the second hand begins to jump in two-second intervals, it indicates a low battery. Battery replacement should be performed by a qualified watch technician to ensure proper sealing and water resistance.

4.3 Cleaning

To clean the watch, wipe the case and bracelet with a soft, dry cloth. For stubborn dirt, a slightly damp cloth can be used, followed by immediate drying. Avoid using harsh chemicals or abrasive materials.

5. TROUBLESHOOTING

5.1 Common Issues and Solutions

- Watch Not Running: Check if the crown is fully pushed in. If it is, the battery may need replacement.
- **Incorrect Time:** Reset the time as described in Section 2.1. If the time continues to be inaccurate, the watch may require servicing.
- Condensation Inside Crystal: This may indicate a loss of water resistance. Avoid further contact with water and have the watch inspected by a technician.
