For Intex Filter Pumps 28601 & 28602 (Model 29007E)

INTRODUCTION

This manual provides essential information for the proper use and maintenance of your Intex Type H Filter Cartridge. Designed for Intex Filter Pumps 28601 and 28602, these cartridges are crucial for maintaining clean and clear swimming pool water. Please read these instructions carefully before installation and use.

PRODUCT OVERVIEW

The Intex Type H Filter Cartridge (Model 29007E) is a replacement filter made from Dacron material, designed for efficient filtration of debris and particles from your pool water. Regular replacement ensures optimal performance of your filter pump.

SETUP AND INSTALLATION

Follow these steps to install the Intex Type H Filter Cartridge into your compatible filter pump:

- 1. **Power Off:** Ensure your filter pump is turned off and unplugged from the power source before beginning installation.
- 2. Close Valves: Close the plunger valves on your pool to prevent water from flowing out of the pump.
- 3. **Open Filter Housing:** Unscrew the collar or lid of the filter pump housing.
- 4. Remove Old Cartridge: Carefully remove the old, used filter cartridge. Dispose of it responsibly.
- 5. **Insert New Cartridge:** Place the new Intex Type H filter cartridge into the filter housing. Ensure it is seated correctly.
- 6. **Secure Housing:** Replace the filter housing lid and tighten the collar securely. Do not overtighten.
- 7. **Open Valves & Power On:** Open the plunger valves and plug in the filter pump. Turn it on to resume filtration.

OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

Once installed, the filter cartridge operates automatically with your Intex filter pump. The pump circulates pool water through the cartridge, which traps dirt and debris. For optimal water clarity, ensure your pump runs for several hours each day, as recommended by your pool's specific requirements.

MAINTENANCE

Regular maintenance of your filter cartridge is essential for efficient pool filtration and pump longevity.

Cleaning the Cartridge

The filter cartridge can be cleaned to extend its lifespan. Follow these steps:

- 1. Power Off: Turn off and unplug the filter pump.
- 2. **Remove Cartridge:** Open the filter housing and remove the cartridge as described in the setup section.
- 3. **Rinse:** Use a garden hose to thoroughly rinse the pleated material of the cartridge. Spray from top to bottom, ensuring all debris is dislodged from the pleats.
- 4. Inspect: Check the cartridge for any tears or damage. If damaged, replace it.
- 5. Reinstall: Reinstall the cleaned cartridge into the pump housing and secure the lid.

Replacement Schedule

For best results and to maintain optimal filtration efficiency, it is recommended to replace the filter cartridge with a new one every **two weeks**. Frequent replacement prevents clogging and ensures your pump operates effectively.

TROUBLESHOOTING

- Reduced Water Flow: If you notice a decrease in water flow from your pump, the filter cartridge may be clogged. Remove and clean the cartridge. If flow does not improve, replace it with a new one.
- Cloudy Pool Water: Cloudy water often indicates inefficient filtration. Ensure the filter cartridge is clean and properly installed. If the problem persists after cleaning, replace the cartridge. Also, check your pool's chemical balance.
- **Pump Not Operating:** Verify the pump is plugged in and receiving power. Check for any blockages in the hoses or pump impeller. Ensure the filter cartridge is correctly seated and the housing is sealed.
