JVC HR-XVC18BU Progressive Scan DVD/VCR Combo Player User Manual

INTRODUCTION

This manual provides comprehensive instructions for the setup, operation, maintenance, and troubleshooting of your JVC HR-XVC18BU Progressive Scan DVD/VCR Combo Player. Please read this manual thoroughly before using the unit to ensure proper operation and to maximize your enjoyment of its features. Keep this manual for future reference.

SAFETY INFORMATION

To reduce the risk of electric shock, fire, or damage to the unit, please observe the following safety precautions:

- Do not expose this appliance to rain or moisture.
- Do not remove the cover. Refer servicing to qualified personnel only.
- Ensure proper ventilation. Do not block ventilation openings.
- Place the unit on a stable, level surface.
- Unplug the unit from the wall outlet during lightning storms or when unused for long periods.
- Do not insert foreign objects into the unit.

SETUP

1. Unpacking

Carefully remove the unit and all accessories from the packaging. Verify that all components are present.

2. Connecting to a Television

The JVC HR-XVC18BU uses RCA connectors for audio and video output. Connect the unit to your television using the appropriate cables.

1. Connect the yellow VIDEO (MONO) output jack on the HR-XVC18BU to the video input jack on your TV.

2. Connect the white L-AUDIO output jack on the HR-XVC18BU to the left audio input jack on your TV.
3. Connect the red R-AUDIO output jack on the HR-XVC18BU to the right audio input jack on your TV.

Ensure the TV input is set to the corresponding video input (e.g., Video 1, AV1) to view the player's output.

3. Power Connection

Plug the AC power cord from the HR-XVC18BU into a standard wall outlet.

OPERATING

Front Panel Controls

The front panel of your JVC HR-XVC18BU features various controls for both DVD and VCR functions:

- **POWER:** Turns the unit on or off.
- **DVD/VIDEO CD/CD Tray:** For inserting DVDs and CDs.
- **OPEN/CLOSE:** Opens and closes the DVD/CD tray.
- **REW (Rewind):** Rewinds VHS tapes.
- **PLAY:** Starts playback for DVD or VCR.
- **FF (Fast Forward):** Fast forwards VHS tapes.
- **STOP:** Stops playback or recording.

- **PAUSE:** Pauses playback.
- **EJECT (VCR):** Ejects a VHS tape.
- **CH- / CH+:** Changes channels during VCR tuner operation.
- **VCR/DVD:** Switches between VCR and DVD modes.
- **REC (Record):** Initiates recording on a VHS tape.
- **VIDEO (MONO) L-AUDIO-R:** Front panel input jacks for connecting external devices.

Basic DVD Playback

1. Press the **POWER** button to turn on the unit.
2. Press the **VCR/DVD** button until the DVD indicator is lit.
3. Press **OPEN/CLOSE** to open the disc tray.
4. Place a DVD or CD onto the tray with the label side up.
5. Press **OPEN/CLOSE** again to close the tray.
6. Playback will usually start automatically. If not, press **PLAY**.

Basic VCR Playback

1. Press the **POWER** button to turn on the unit.
2. Press the **VCR/DVD** button until the VCR indicator is lit.
3. Insert a VHS tape into the VCR slot. The unit will typically load the tape automatically.
4. Press **PLAY** to begin playback.
5. Use **REW**, **FF**, **STOP**, and **PAUSE** for tape control.
6. To eject the tape, press the **EJECT** button.

Recording on VCR

To record from an external source connected to the front A/V inputs:

1. Ensure the unit is in VCR mode.
2. Insert a recordable VHS tape.
3. Connect the external source (e.g., camcorder) to the front panel **VIDEO (MONO) L-AUDIO-R** input jacks.
4. Start playback on your external source.
5. Press the **REC** button on the HR-XVC18BU to begin recording.
6. Press **STOP** to end recording.

MAINTENANCE

Cleaning the Unit

- Wipe the exterior of the unit with a soft, dry cloth.
- Do not use liquid or aerosol cleaners, as they may damage the finish or internal components.

VCR Head Cleaning

If you experience poor picture quality during VHS playback (e.g., static, distorted image), the VCR heads may need cleaning. Use a dry-type VCR head cleaning cassette according to its instructions. Avoid wet-type cleaners as they can cause damage.

TROUBLESHOOTING

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
No power	Power cord unplugged; power outlet not active.	Ensure power cord is securely plugged in. Test the outlet with another device.
No picture/sound	Incorrect TV input selected; A/V cables loose or incorrectly connected.	Select the correct TV input (e.g., AV1, Video 1). Check all A/V cable connections.
Disc not playing	Disc is dirty or scratched; disc inserted incorrectly; incompatible disc format.	Clean the disc with a soft cloth. Insert disc with label side up. Ensure disc is a compatible format (DVD, CD).
Tape not playing/recording	Tape is damaged; VCR heads are dirty; write-protect tab engaged.	Try a different tape. Clean VCR heads. Ensure the write-protect tab on the VHS tape is not engaged for recording.
