INTRODUCTION

This manual provides comprehensive instructions for the setup, operation, and maintenance of your RCA RCR160SBM1 Directv TV Remote Control. This remote is designed to work with specific models, including DSM635RH and DRD435RH, as well as CMT1496, CMT2097, CMT2195, CMT2196, CMT2198, DSM535RH, and DSM586RH. Please read this manual thoroughly to ensure proper use and to maximize the functionality of your remote control.

SETUP

1. Battery Installation

- 1. Locate the battery compartment on the back of the remote control.
- 2. Slide the battery compartment cover downwards or in the direction indicated by an arrow to open it.
- 3. Insert two AAA batteries (not included), ensuring the positive (+) and negative (-) terminals align with the markings inside the compartment.
- 4. Replace the battery compartment cover by sliding it back into place until it clicks securely.

2. Initial Setup / Programming (if required)

This remote is designed to work with specific DIRECTV models. In most cases, it should function immediately with compatible DIRECTV receivers. If the remote does not respond, or if you wish to control other devices (like a TV or DVD player), programming may be required. Refer to your DIRECTV receiver's user manual for specific remote programming instructions, or visit the official RCA support website for universal remote programming codes and methods.

• For DIRECTV Receivers: Ensure your receiver is powered on. Point the remote at the receiver and press any

button. If it responds, no further programming is needed for the receiver.

• For Other Devices (TV, DVD, VCR): Programming typically involves entering a specific code for your device's brand. Consult the RCA support website or the original remote's manual for code lists and programming steps.

OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

This section details the functions of the buttons on your RCA RCR160SBM1 remote control.



Button Functions

- Device Selection Buttons (Top Right):
 - VCR: Selects VCR mode.
 - **DVD:** Selects DVD player mode.
 - AUX1 / AUX2: Selects auxiliary device modes.
 - DIRECTV: Selects DIRECTV receiver mode.
 - TV: Selects Television mode.
- · Power & Mute:

- ON-OFF: Powers the selected device on or off.
- MUTE: Mutes or unmutes the audio.

Navigation & Channel/Volume:

- **VOL** +/-: Adjusts the volume up or down.
- CH +/-: Changes the channel up or down.
- Arrow Buttons (Up, Down, Left, Right): Navigates menus and guides.
- SELECT: Confirms a selection in menus.

. Menu & Information:

- MENU: Opens the main menu of the selected device.
- GUIDE: Displays the program guide.
- INFO: Displays information about the current program or selected item.
- GO BACK: Returns to the previous screen or menu.
- FETCH: (Specific function, may vary by device) Often used to recall previous channel or information.
- SKIP: Skips forward in content or through channels.

• Number Pad (0-9):

• Used to directly enter channel numbers or other numerical inputs.

• Playback Controls:

- **RECORD:** Initiates recording of the current program.
- STOP: Stops playback or recording.
- PLAY: Starts playback of content.
- PAUSE: Pauses playback.
- REVERSE: Rewinds content.
- FORWARD: Fast forwards content.

• Other Buttons:

- WHO-INPUT: (Specific function, may vary by device) Often used to switch video inputs or display input information.
- ANTENNA: (Specific function, may vary by device) May switch between antenna and cable/satellite inputs.
- CLEAR: Clears entered numbers or dismisses on-screen messages.

MAINTENANCE

Cleaning the Remote

To maintain the appearance and functionality of your remote control, clean it regularly:

- Use a soft, dry cloth to wipe the surface of the remote.
- For stubborn dirt, slightly dampen the cloth with water or a mild, non-abrasive cleaner. Do not spray cleaner directly onto the remote.
- · Avoid using harsh chemicals, solvents, or abrasive cleaning pads, as these can damage the remote's finish or

internal components.

Battery Replacement

Replace batteries when the remote's performance degrades or it stops responding. Refer to the "Battery Installation" section under Setup for detailed steps. Always use new batteries of the specified type (AAA) and dispose of old batteries responsibly according to local regulations.

TROUBLESHOOTING

If you encounter issues with your remote control, try the following solutions:

Problem	Possible Cause / Solution
Remote is not responding.	 Batteries: Check if batteries are inserted correctly with correct polarity. Replace old or dead batteries with new ones. Line of Sight: Ensure there are no obstructions between the remote and the device. Point the remote directly at the device's IR sensor. Device Selection: Make sure the correct device button (e.g., DIRECTV, TV, DVD) is selected for the device you are trying to control.
Remote has limited range or intermittent response.	 Low Batteries: Replace batteries. Interference: Strong light sources (like direct sunlight or fluorescent lights) can interfere with the IR signal. Try using the remote in a different lighting condition.
Certain buttons do not work.	 Device Mode: Ensure you are in the correct device mode for the button's function (e.g., TV volume buttons may only work in TV mode). Programming: If the remote was programmed for multiple devices, ensure the programming is correct for all functions. Re-program if necessary. Stuck Button: Check if the button is physically stuck or damaged.
Remote does not control my specific DIRECTV receiver/TV.	 Compatibility: Verify that your device model is listed as compatible with the RCA RCR160SBM1 remote. Programming: The remote may need to be programmed or paired with your specific DIRECTV receiver or TV. Consult your device's manual or RCA's support resources for programming codes and instructions.
