INTRODUCTION

This user manual provides essential information for the safe and efficient operation of your new Zanussi ZWF71240W front-load washing machine. Please read these instructions carefully before using the appliance and keep them for future reference. Proper use and maintenance will ensure optimal performance and longevity of your washing machine.

SETUP AND INSTALLATION

Before connecting your washing machine, ensure it is placed on a stable, level surface. Proper installation is crucial for safe operation and to minimize noise and vibration.

Unpacking

- Carefully remove all packaging materials, including the polystyrene base and any protective film.
- Remove the transport bolts located at the rear of the machine. These bolts secure the drum during transit and **must** be removed before use. Keep them for future transport.

Leveling the Appliance

- Use a spirit level to check if the machine is perfectly level.
- Adjust the adjustable feet at the bottom of the machine until it is stable and level on all four corners.

Water and Electrical Connections

- Connect the water inlet hose to a cold water tap with a 3/4-inch thread. Ensure the connection is tight to prevent leaks.
- Position the drain hose into a standpipe or over the edge of a sink, ensuring it is securely fixed to prevent displacement during draining.
- Plug the power cord into a grounded electrical outlet. Ensure the voltage and frequency match the specifications on the rating plate of the appliance.

OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

Your Zanussi ZWF71240W washing machine offers various programs and functions to suit different laundry needs. Familiarize yourself with the control panel and program selector.

Control Panel Overview

The control panel typically includes a program selector dial, function buttons (e.g., Quick Wash, Delay Start), and indicator lights.

Loading Laundry

- Open the washing machine door and load laundry loosely into the drum. Do not overload the machine; the maximum capacity is 7 kg.
- Close the door firmly until it clicks shut.

Adding Detergent and Additives

- Pull out the detergent dispenser drawer.
- Add appropriate amounts of detergent to the main wash compartment and fabric softener to its designated compartment. Refer to detergent packaging for dosage recommendations.
- Push the dispenser drawer back in completely.

Selecting a Program

- Turn the program selector dial to choose the desired wash program (e.g., Cotton, Synthetics, Delicates, Wool, Jeans).
- For a quick wash, select the **Quick Wash** function to reduce the cycle time, completing a wash in approximately 30 minutes for smaller loads.
- To delay the start of a wash cycle, use the **Delay Start** function. This allows you to program the machine to start at a more convenient time.

Starting and Stopping a Cycle

- Press the Start/Pause button to begin the selected program.
- To pause a cycle, press the Start/Pause button again. Press it once more to resume.
- To cancel a program, turn the program selector dial to the 'Off' position, then select a new program or turn the machine off.

MAINTENANCE

Regular maintenance ensures your washing machine operates efficiently and extends its lifespan.

Cleaning the Detergent Dispenser

- Pull out the dispenser drawer completely.
- Remove any removable parts and rinse them under running water.
- Clean the drawer housing with a brush.
- Reassemble and reinsert the drawer.

Cleaning the Drum

- Periodically run a maintenance wash cycle (e.g., a hot wash with no laundry and a descaling agent) to prevent odor and residue buildup.

Cleaning the Drain Filter

- Locate the drain filter, usually at the bottom front of the machine.
- Place a shallow container underneath to catch any residual water.
- Carefully unscrew and remove the filter.
- Clean any lint, debris, or foreign objects from the filter and its housing.
- Screw the filter back in securely.

Care for the Exterior

- Wipe the exterior surfaces with a soft, damp cloth. Do not use abrasive cleaners or solvents.

TROUBLESHOOTING

Before contacting customer service, refer to the following common issues and their solutions.

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Machine does not start	No power; Door not closed; Program not selected.	Check power supply; Ensure door is firmly closed; Select a program and press Start.
Excessive vibration/noise	Transport bolts not removed; Machine not level; Uneven load.	Remove transport bolts; Adjust feet to level machine; Redistribute laundry in drum.
Water not draining	Drain hose kinked/blocked; Drain filter clogged.	Check and clear drain hose; Clean the drain filter.
Detergent residue in dispenser	Insufficient water pressure; Detergent clumping.	Check water supply; Clean dispenser drawer; Use less detergent or a different type.
