INTRODUCTION

SETUP AND INSTALLATION

The Briggs & Stratton 695951 Key is designed for straightforward installation into compatible ignition switches. Follow these steps for proper installation:

- 1. Locate the Ignition Switch:** Identify the ignition switch on your Briggs & Stratton equipment. Ensure the equipment is turned off and any safety measures are in place.
- 2. Insert the Key:** Gently insert the 695951 key into the ignition switch slot. The key should slide in smoothly without resistance. Do not force the key.
- 3. Verify Fit:** The key should seat properly within the switch. If it does not, double-check your equipment's model number against the key's compatibility specifications.

OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

Once the key is properly inserted, it can be used to operate your equipment's ignition system:

- Starting the Engine:** Turn the key clockwise to the "START" position to engage the starter motor. Release the key once the engine starts; it will typically return to the "RUN" position automatically.

TROUBLESHOOTING

- Key Does Not Insert Smoothly:** Ensure you have the correct key for your equipment model. Do not force the key, as this can damage both the key and the ignition switch. Verify there are no obstructions in the ignition switch.
- Engine Does Not Start:** If the key turns but the engine does not start, check other components of your equipment's starting system (e.g., battery charge, fuel level, spark plug condition, safety switches). This key is an ignition component, but other factors can prevent starting.
- Key Is Stuck or Hard to Turn:** Inspect the ignition switch for any obstructions or damage. A small amount of graphite lubricant can sometimes help, but if the issue persists, consult a qualified technician to inspect the ignition switch.
