### 1. PRODUCT OVERVIEW

## 2. INSTALLATION GUIDELINES

Proper installation is crucial for the safety and performance of your Continental SPORT CONTACT 3 tires. It is highly recommended that tire installation be performed by a qualified professional using appropriate equipment.

### General Steps for Professional Installation:

1. **Inspection:** The installer should inspect the wheels for damage, corrosion, or defects before mounting new tires.
2. **Mounting:** Tires must be mounted on approved rims of the correct size. Use proper lubrication and mounting techniques to avoid damage to the tire bead.

3. **Balancing:** All new tires should be dynamically balanced to prevent vibrations and ensure even wear.
4. **Inflation:** Inflate tires to the vehicle manufacturer's recommended pressure, typically found on a placard inside the driver's side door jamb or in the owner's manual. Never exceed the maximum pressure molded on the tire sidewall.
5. **Alignment:** After installation, a wheel alignment check is recommended to ensure optimal handling and tire longevity.

### 3. OPERATING RECOMMENDATIONS

To maximize the performance and lifespan of your Continental SPORT CONTACT 3 tires, adhere to the following



operating recommendations:

### Tire Pressure:

- Maintain correct tire inflation pressure as specified by your vehicle manufacturer. Check pressure regularly, at least once a month and before long trips, when tires are cold.
- Under-inflation or over-inflation can lead to premature wear, reduced fuel efficiency, and compromised handling.

### Driving Conditions:

- While designed for all-weather traction, these are summer performance tires. Exercise caution in extreme cold or snowy conditions, as their performance may be reduced compared to dedicated winter tires.
- Avoid sudden acceleration, braking, and sharp turns, especially on wet or uneven surfaces, to prevent excessive tire wear and maintain control.

## 4. MAINTENANCE AND CARE

Regular maintenance extends the life of your tires and ensures consistent performance.

### Tire Rotation:

- Rotate your tires every 5,000 to 7,500 miles, or as recommended by your vehicle manufacturer, to promote even wear across all four tires.

### **Wheel Alignment and Balancing:**

- Have your wheel alignment checked annually or if you notice uneven tire wear or steering issues.
- Re-balance tires if you experience vibrations in the steering wheel or seat.

### **Tread Depth Inspection:**

- Regularly inspect tread depth. The legal minimum tread depth is typically 2/32 of an inch. Replace tires before they reach this limit for optimal safety and performance.
- Look for wear indicators (small bars molded into the tread grooves) that become flush with the tread surface when the tire is worn out.

## 5. TROUBLESHOOTING COMMON ISSUES

Addressing common tire issues promptly can prevent further damage and ensure safety.

### Uneven Tire Wear:

- **Center Wear:** Often caused by over-inflation. Adjust tire pressure to vehicle manufacturer specifications.
- **Edge Wear:** Typically caused by under-inflation. Adjust tire pressure to vehicle manufacturer specifications.
- **Feathering/Scalloping:** May indicate alignment issues or worn suspension components. Have your vehicle inspected by a professional.

### Vibration:

- Vibrations can be caused by unbalanced tires, bent rims, or worn suspension parts. Have tires re-balanced and vehicle inspected.

### Punctures and Damage:

- If a tire is punctured, it should be inspected by a professional to determine if it can be safely repaired or if replacement is necessary. Do not attempt to repair significant sidewall damage.
