1. INTRODUCTION

This manual provides essential instructions for the safe and efficient operation of your GPX PD901VPB Portable DVD Player. Please read this manual thoroughly before using the device and retain it for future reference.

3. PRODUCT FEATURES

- 9-inch LCD Swivel Display (800 x 480 resolution)

4. SETUP

4.1. Charging the Battery

1. Connect the AC power adapter to the DC IN jack on the DVD player.
2. Plug the AC power adapter into a standard wall outlet.
3. The charging indicator light will illuminate. Allow approximately 4-5 hours for a full charge.
4. The indicator light will change or turn off when charging is complete.

4.2. Installing Remote Control Batteries

1. Open the battery compartment on the back of the remote control.
2. Insert two AAA batteries, ensuring correct polarity (+/-).
3. Close the battery compartment.

4.3. Powering On/Off

- To power on, slide the POWER switch to the ON position.
- To power off, slide the POWER switch to the OFF position.

5. OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

5.1. Loading a Disc

1. Open the disc compartment cover.
2. Place a DVD or CD onto the spindle with the label side facing up.
3. Gently press the disc until it clicks into place.
4. Close the disc compartment cover.
5. The player will automatically begin reading the disc.

5.2. Basic Playback Controls

- **PLAY/PAUSE:** Press to start or pause playback.
- **STOP:** Press once to stop playback, press twice to return to the beginning of the disc.
- **SKIP (<< / >>):** Press to skip to the previous or next chapter/track.
- **FAST FORWARD/REWIND:** Press and hold to fast forward or rewind.
- **VOLUME (+/-):** Adjust the audio output level.
- **MENU:** Access the disc's main menu.

5.3. Using USB/SD Media

1. Insert a USB flash drive into the USB port or an SD card into the SD card slot.
2. The player should automatically detect the media and display a menu.
3. Use the navigation buttons (UP/DOWN/LEFT/RIGHT) and ENTER to select files for playback.

5.4. Connecting to an External Display

To view content on a larger screen, use the included AV cable:

1. Connect one end of the AV cable to the AV OUT jack on the portable DVD player.
2. Connect the other end of the AV cable to the corresponding AV INPUT jacks (Yellow for Video, White for Left Audio, Red for Right Audio) on your television or monitor.
3. Select the correct AV input source on your external display.

6. MAINTENANCE

- **Cleaning the Unit:** Use a soft, dry cloth to clean the exterior of the player. Do not use liquid cleaners or abrasive materials.
- **Cleaning Discs:** Wipe discs gently from the center outwards with a soft, lint-free cloth. Avoid touching the playback surface.
- **Storage:** Store the player in a cool, dry place away from direct sunlight and extreme temperatures.
- **Battery Care:** To prolong battery life, fully charge the player before first use and periodically if not used for extended periods.

7. TROUBLESHOOTING

Problem	Possible Solution
No power	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Ensure the power adapter is securely connected.• Check if the battery is charged.• Verify the POWER switch is in the ON position.

Problem	Possible Solution
Disc not playing	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Check if the disc is inserted correctly (label side up). • Clean the disc for smudges or scratches. • Ensure the disc format is supported (DVD, CD). • Try a different disc.
No sound	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Increase the volume. • Check headphone connections if using headphones. • Ensure external speakers/TV are properly connected and volume is up.
Remote control not working	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Replace the AAA batteries. • Ensure there are no obstructions between the remote and the player's IR sensor. • Point the remote directly at the player.






