PRODUCT OVERVIEW

SETUP

TROUBLESHOOTING

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Clipper not cutting line cleanly.	Dull blades, improper line positioning, or attempting to cut braided line without proper technique.	Ensure line is positioned correctly. Apply firm, steady pressure. For braided line, try a quick, sharp snap. Consider blade maintenance or replacement if dullness persists.
Retractable reel not retracting fully.	Debris in mechanism, spring fatigue, or cord entanglement.	Clean the reel mechanism. Ensure the cord is not twisted or tangled. If the issue persists, the reel mechanism may be worn.
Clipper feels stiff or rusty.	Lack of lubrication, exposure to moisture/saltwater without cleaning.	Clean thoroughly with fresh water and dry. Apply a corrosion-inhibiting lubricant to all moving parts.
