Engine Oil & Filter	Every 10,000 miles or 1 year	Replace oil and filter (synthetic oil recommended)
Brake Fluid	Every 2 years	Replace fluid (DOT4 recommended)
Spark Plugs	Every 40,000 miles	Replace (check gap before installation)
Air Filter	Every 20,000 miles or 2 years	Inspect and replace if dirty
