## SETUP AND PROGRAMMING

---

Programming this keyless entry remote requires specific conditions. Please follow the instructions carefully.

### Self-Programming Instructions:

Self-programming is possible only if you have **one existing, working remote** for your vehicle. A link to free self-programming instructions is typically provided with the product purchase. Follow those specific instructions for your vehicle model.

### Professional Programming:

If you do not have an existing, working remote, professional programming by a local automotive locksmith is required. Dealerships may also offer this service, but locksmiths often provide a more cost-effective solution.

## OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

---

Once programmed, the remote operates the vehicle's keyless entry system. The functions are typically as follows:

- **Unlock Button (Open Padlock Icon):** Press once to unlock the driver's door. Press twice to unlock all doors.
- **Lock Button (Closed Padlock Icon):** Press once to lock all doors.
- **Panic Button (Red 'PANIC' Button):** Press and hold for a few seconds to activate the vehicle's alarm system. Press again to deactivate.

## MAINTENANCE

---

The remote comes with a new battery installed. When the remote's range decreases or it becomes unresponsive, the battery may need replacement. Refer to your vehicle's owner's manual or a qualified technician for battery replacement procedures specific to this remote model.

Keep the remote dry and avoid exposing it to extreme temperatures or direct sunlight for prolonged periods.

## TROUBLESHOOTING

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Remote does not work after programming attempt.	Incorrect programming procedure; no existing working remote; remote incompatibility.	Ensure you followed the correct self-programming steps for your vehicle. If no existing remote, professional programming is required. Verify FCC ID and Part Number match your vehicle's requirements.
Remote range is poor or intermittent.	Low battery; signal interference.	Replace the battery. Avoid using the remote near strong radio frequency sources.
Buttons are unresponsive.	Internal damage; low battery.	Check battery. If issue persists, the remote may be damaged and require replacement.
