1. Introduction

This manual provides essential information for setting up, operating, maintaining, and troubleshooting your Wacom Cintiq 27QHD creative pen display. Please read this manual thoroughly to ensure proper use and to maximize your creative experience.

The Wacom Cintiq 27QHD (DTK2700) is a high-definition creative pen display designed for professional artists and designers, offering advanced color and resolution for natural creative expression.

2. SETUP

2.1 Unboxing and Initial Inspection

Carefully remove all components from the packaging. Verify that all items listed in the "What's in the Box" section are present and undamaged.

2.2 Connecting the Cintiq to Your Computer

The Cintiq 27QHD requires both video and USB connections to your computer. Ensure your computer meets the minimum system requirements.

- 1. Power Connection: Connect the power adapter to the Cintiq and then to a power outlet.
- 2. **Video Connection:** Connect either the HDMI cable or the DisplayPort cable from your computer's video output to the corresponding input on the Cintiq. For optimal resolution (2560 x 1440), DisplayPort is recommended.
- 3. **USB Connection:** Connect the USB 3.0 cable from your computer's USB port to the Cintiq's USB port. This enables pen and touch functionality.

2.3 Driver Installation

After connecting the hardware, install the latest drivers from the Wacom website or the provided installation CD. Restart your computer after installation.

- 1. Download the latest driver for your operating system (Windows or macOS) from the official Wacom support website.
- 2. Run the installer and follow the on-screen instructions.
- 3. Restart your computer when prompted.
- 4. Open the Wacom Desktop Center to configure your display and pen settings.

3. OPERATING YOUR CINTIQ 27QHD

3.1 Powering On/Off

Press the power button located on the top right side of the display to turn the Cintiq on or off. An indicator light will show the power status.

3.2 Using the Pro Pen

The Pro Pen offers 2048 levels of pressure sensitivity for precise control. It is battery-free and uses electromagnetic resonance technology.

- **Pen Nibs:** The pen comes with various nibs (standard, felt, stroke, flex) for different drawing sensations. Replace nibs using the nib removal tool found in the pen stand.
- **Side Switches:** The Pro Pen features customizable side switches for functions like right-click, scroll, or modifier keys. Configure these in the Wacom Desktop Center.

3.3 ExpressKey Remote

The ExpressKey Remote provides customizable shortcut buttons and a Touch Ring to enhance your workflow. It can be placed anywhere on or off the screen for convenience.

- **Customization:** Assign frequently used keyboard shortcuts, mouse clicks, or navigation functions to the ExpressKeys and Touch Ring in the Wacom Desktop Center.
- Placement: The remote is magnetic and can attach to the bezel of the Cintiq or be held in hand.

3.4 Display Settings

Adjust brightness, contrast, and color settings through your computer's display settings or the Wacom Desktop Center for optimal visual performance.

4. MAINTENANCE

4.1 Cleaning the Display

Use the provided cleaning cloth or a soft, lint-free cloth slightly dampened with water to clean the screen. Avoid harsh chemicals or abrasive materials.

4.2 Pen Nib Replacement

Regularly inspect your pen nibs for wear. Replace them when they become too short or sharp to maintain optimal drawing performance. Use the nib removal tool to gently pull out the old nib and insert a new one.

4.3 Software Updates

Keep your Wacom drivers and software updated to ensure compatibility and access to the latest features and performance improvements. Check the Wacom Desktop Center regularly for updates.

5. TROUBLESHOOTING

5.1 No Display on Cintiq

- Ensure all video cables (HDMI/DisplayPort) are securely connected to both the Cintiq and your computer.
- Verify the Cintiq is powered on and the power adapter is connected.
- Check your computer's display settings to ensure the Cintiq is detected and configured as an extended or mirrored display.

5.2 Pen or Touch Not Responding

- Confirm the USB cable is securely connected to both the Cintiq and your computer.
- Ensure Wacom drivers are correctly installed and up to date. Reinstall if necessary.
- Check the Wacom Desktop Center for any error messages or device status.
- Test the pen on another compatible Wacom device if available, or try a different pen if you have one.

5.3 Color Inaccuracy

- Calibrate your display using a color calibration device for professional color accuracy.
- · Adjust color settings in the Wacom Desktop Center or your operating system's display settings.
