1. PRODUCT OVERVIEW

This manual provides essential information regarding the Ski-Doo OEM Nylon Screw, part number 250100058. This is a genuine factory original equipment part designed for specific Ski-Doo applications. It is not an aftermarket component.

3. SETUP AND INSTALLATION

This nylon screw is designed for specific applications within Ski-Doo snowmobiles or other compatible equipment. Proper installation is crucial for ensuring the integrity and safety of the assembly.

1. **Verify Fitment:** Before installation, confirm that this screw (Part Number 250100058) is the correct component for your specific Ski-Doo model and application. Refer to your vehicle's official service

manual or parts catalog for accurate fitment information.

2. **Prepare Installation Area:** Ensure the receiving hole and surrounding area are clean and free from debris, old thread residue, or damage.
3. **Installation:** Carefully align the nylon screw with the threaded hole. Turn the screw clockwise by hand until it engages the threads. Use appropriate tools (e.g., a screwdriver) to tighten the screw.
4. **Tightening Torque:** Avoid overtightening nylon screws, as this can strip the threads or damage the component. Tighten only until snug, or refer to the manufacturer's specifications for precise torque values if available for your application.
5. **Post-Installation Check:** After installation, visually inspect the screw to ensure it is seated correctly and securely.

***Note:** Incorrect installation can lead to component failure or damage. If you are unsure about the installation process, consult a qualified technician or refer to official Ski-Doo service documentation.*

4. OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

As a static fastening component, the Ski-Doo OEM Nylon Screw does not have operational instructions. Its function is to secure other parts in place. Once installed correctly, it performs its intended role without further user interaction.

5. MAINTENANCE

The Ski-Doo OEM Nylon Screw requires minimal maintenance. However, periodic inspection is recommended as part of your vehicle's overall maintenance schedule.

- **Visual Inspection:** Regularly check the screw for any signs of loosening, cracking, or damage, especially after periods of heavy use or exposure to harsh conditions.
- **Cleaning:** If necessary, clean the screw and surrounding area with a mild cleaner and soft cloth. Avoid harsh chemicals that could degrade the nylon material.
- **Replacement:** If the screw shows any signs of wear, damage, or if it becomes loose and cannot be re-tightened securely, it should be replaced with a new genuine Ski-Doo OEM Nylon Screw (Part Number 250100058) to maintain structural integrity.

6. TROUBLESHOOTING

As a passive fastening component, the Ski-Doo OEM Nylon Screw typically does not require troubleshooting. Issues related to screws usually stem from incorrect installation or damage. If you encounter problems such as a loose component or a screw that will not tighten, consider the following:

- **Screw Not Tightening:** This may indicate stripped threads in the receiving component or on the screw itself. Inspect both the screw and the hole. If threads are stripped, replacement of the screw and/or repair of the receiving component may be necessary.
- **Component Loosening:** Ensure the screw was tightened to the appropriate specification. Vibration can cause fasteners to loosen over time. Re-tighten the screw. If it repeatedly loosens, consider if the correct screw type is being used for the application or if there is excessive vibration.

***Warning:** Do not attempt to force a damaged screw or use an incorrect size, as this can cause further damage to your equipment.*
