

3. SETUP INSTRUCTIONS

Follow these steps to assemble your BRIO My First Railway Beginner Pack:

- Unpack Components:** Carefully remove all 18 pieces from the packaging.
- Assemble the Track:** Connect the wooden track pieces by aligning the interlocking ends. The set allows for various track layouts, including a circular path with an elevated section.
- Install the Bridge:** Place the colourful bridge/tunnel structure onto the designated track pieces to create an overpass.
- Position Guiding Ramps:** Attach the four guiding ramp tracks at points where the train can easily transition onto or off the main track. These ramps are designed to assist younger children in placing the train on the rails.
- Connect Train and Wagon:** Use the magnetic connectors to link the train engine and the rattle carriage together.
- Place Train on Track:** Gently place the assembled train and wagon onto the track. Ensure all wheels are properly

seated in the track grooves.

5. MAINTENANCE AND CARE

To ensure the longevity and cleanliness of your BRIO My First Railway Beginner Pack, follow these simple maintenance guidelines:

- **Cleaning:** Wipe all wooden and plastic components with a damp cloth. For stubborn dirt, a mild soap solution can be used, followed by wiping with a clean, damp cloth. Ensure all parts are thoroughly dried before storage to prevent warping or damage to the wood.
- **Storage:** Store the train set in a dry place away from direct sunlight and extreme temperatures. Proper storage helps maintain the integrity of the wood and colors.
- **Inspection:** Periodically inspect all pieces for any signs of wear, damage, or loose parts. Discontinue use if any part is broken or poses a safety risk.

6. TROUBLESHOOTING

Here are solutions to common issues you might encounter with your train set:

Problem	Solution
Train frequently derails.	Ensure all track pieces are securely connected and lie flat on the playing surface. Check that the train's wheels are properly aligned within the track grooves. For younger children, guide them on how to gently place the train back on the track.
Track pieces do not connect properly.	Verify that the correct track pieces are being used for the desired connection. Some pieces may have specific male/female ends. Ensure there is no debris in the connection points.
Train cars detach during play.	While the magnetic connections are strong, excessive force or sudden movements can cause detachment. Reconnect the cars by bringing the magnetic ends close together. Ensure the magnets are clean and free of obstructions.



