INTRODUCTION

Thank you for choosing Duracell Procell AAA 1.5V Alkaline Batteries. This manual provides important information regarding the safe handling, installation, usage, and disposal of your batteries to ensure optimal performance and longevity. Please read these instructions carefully before use.

SAFETY INFORMATION

To prevent injury or damage to your devices, please observe the following safety precautions:

- **Do not recharge:** These are single-use alkaline batteries and are not designed to be recharged. Attempting to recharge may cause leakage, fire, or explosion.
- **Do not disassemble or mutilate:** Opening or damaging the battery can release hazardous materials.
- **Do not expose to fire or extreme temperatures:** High temperatures can cause batteries to rupture or leak.
- **Keep out of reach of children:** Batteries can be swallowed, posing a choking hazard and chemical burn risk. Seek immediate medical attention if a battery is swallowed.
- **Do not mix battery types:** Avoid mixing new and used batteries, or different brands/types of batteries, as this can lead to leakage or reduced performance.
- **Insert correctly:** Always ensure batteries are inserted with the correct polarity (+ and -) as indicated in your device.
- **Remove exhausted batteries promptly:** Old batteries can leak and damage devices.
- **Store properly:** Store batteries in their original packaging in a cool, dry place.

SETUP AND INSTALLATION

Follow these steps to properly install your Duracell Procell AAA batteries:

1. Identify the battery compartment on your electronic device.
2. Open the battery compartment cover.
3. Observe the polarity markings (+ and -) inside the compartment.
4. Insert the Duracell Procell AAA batteries, aligning the positive (+) end of the battery with the positive (+)

terminal in the device, and the negative (-) end with the negative (-) terminal.

5. Close the battery compartment cover securely.

OPERATING GUIDELINES

Duracell Procell AAA batteries are designed for reliable operation in a wide range of professional and high-drain devices. Once installed correctly, they will power your device until depleted. No specific operational steps are required for the batteries themselves beyond proper installation.

MAINTENANCE AND STORAGE

Proper maintenance and storage can significantly extend the shelf life and performance of your batteries:

- **Storage Temperature:** Store batteries in a cool, dry place, ideally between -4°F to 129°F (-20°C to 54°C). Avoid extreme heat or direct sunlight.
- **Shelf Life:** These batteries have a 7-year shelf life. Each battery is individually date-coded to ensure freshness.
- **Packaging:** Keep unused batteries in their original packaging to prevent short-circuiting and protect terminals.
- **Cleaning:** If battery terminals become dirty, gently wipe them with a clean, dry cloth.

TROUBLESHOOTING

If your device is not functioning correctly after battery installation, consider the following:

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Device does not power on.	Incorrect battery installation or depleted batteries.	Check battery polarity (+/-). Replace with fresh batteries if necessary.

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Device powers on but functions intermittently.	Low battery power or poor contact.	Replace batteries. Ensure battery terminals and device contacts are clean and free of corrosion.
Battery leakage observed.	Over-discharge, extreme temperatures, or mixing battery types.	Remove leaking batteries carefully (wear gloves). Clean device compartment. Ensure proper usage and storage. Dispose of leaking batteries according to local regulations.
