# Outdoor Trampoline Assembly Instruction Manual

Your guide to safe and enjoyable trampoline use.

## INTRODUCTION

---

Safety pad keeps shifting.	Ties/straps are loose or broken.	Re-secure or replace ties/straps.
Enclosure net is sagging or torn.	Loose attachments; material damage.	Re-tighten net attachments; replace the net if torn.
