Patio Set Assembly Instructions

1. INTRODUCTION

This manual provides detailed instructions for the safe and correct assembly of your new patio set. Please read all instructions thoroughly before beginning assembly. Keep this manual for future reference.

2. SAFETY INFORMATION

Always prioritize safety during assembly. Failure to follow these guidelines may result in injury or damage to the product.

- **Keep children and pets away:** Ensure children and pets are kept away from the assembly area. Small parts can be a choking hazard.
- **Work on a level surface:** Assemble the patio set on a flat, stable, and clean surface to prevent wobbling or tipping during construction.
- **Use appropriate tools:** Only use the tools specified in this manual or suitable alternatives. Do not overtighten fasteners.
- **Inspect all parts:** Before assembly, check all components for any damage or missing parts. Contact customer support immediately if issues are found.
- **Do not stand on furniture:** Never stand or climb on the furniture during or after assembly.
- **Two-person assembly:** Some steps may require two adults for safe and efficient assembly.

3. PARTS LIST

Verify that all components listed below are present before starting assembly. Quantities may vary based on your specific patio set model.

4. TOOLS REQUIRED

The following tools are typically required for assembly. An Allen wrench is usually included in the hardware pack.

- Allen Wrench (provided)

5. ASSEMBLY INSTRUCTIONS

5.1. Assemble the Table

1. **Attach Legs to Tabletop:** Place the tabletop (Part A) upside down on a soft, clean surface. Attach each table leg (Part B) to the tabletop using the provided bolts and washers from the hardware pack (Part F). Hand-tighten only.
2. **Secure Legs:** Once all legs are attached, carefully turn the table upright. Ensure it is stable, then fully tighten all bolts with the Allen wrench.

5.2. Assemble the Chairs

1. **Connect Seat and Backrest:** Attach the chair backrest (Part D) to the chair seat (Part C) using bolts and washers. Do not fully tighten.
2. **Attach Legs:** Connect the chair legs (Part E) to the assembled seat and backrest frame. Ensure all connections are loose.
3. **Final Tightening:** Place the chair on a level surface. Apply slight downward pressure to ensure all parts are aligned, then fully tighten all bolts. Repeat for all chairs.

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Wobbly Table/Chair	Fasteners not fully tightened; uneven assembly.	Loosen all fasteners slightly, place the item on a level surface, apply gentle pressure, then retighten all fasteners evenly.
Missing Parts	Packaging error.	Review the parts list carefully. Contact customer support with the specific part number(s) needed.
Difficulty Aligning Holes	Parts are not correctly oriented or fasteners are overtightened prematurely.	Ensure all fasteners are only hand-tightened initially. Re-check part orientation. Try wiggling parts gently to align holes.
