INTRODUCTION

This manual provides comprehensive instructions for the installation, operation, and maintenance of your Fermax 6201 Automatic Intercom Kit. This single-line intercom system is designed for reliable communication and access control, featuring durable construction and ease of use. Please read this manual thoroughly before installation and operation to ensure proper functioning and safety.

SAFETY INFORMATION

Always adhere to the following safety precautions to prevent damage to the unit or injury to personnel:

- Ensure the power supply is disconnected before performing any installation or maintenance.
- Installation should be performed by qualified personnel in accordance with local electrical codes.
- Do not expose the unit to excessive moisture, rain, or extreme temperatures.
- Do not attempt to open or repair the unit yourself. Refer all servicing to authorized service personnel.
- Use only the specified 12-V adapter included with the kit.

- 1 x Outdoor Panel (Anodised Aluminium)
- 1 x Indoor Unit (White ABS Plastic)
- 1 x 12-V Power Adapter
- Mounting Hardware (Screws, Wall Plugs)

SETUP AND INSTALLATION

The Fermax 6201 intercom kit is designed for easy installation. Follow these steps carefully:

1. Outdoor Panel Installation

1. **Choose Location:** Select a suitable location near the entrance, protected from direct heavy rain if possible, at a height accessible to all users.
2. **Mounting:** Use the provided mounting hardware to securely attach the outdoor panel to the wall. Ensure proper alignment.
3. **Wiring:** Connect the necessary wiring from the outdoor panel to the indoor unit and power supply according to the wiring diagram (refer to the detailed installation manual PDF for specific wiring diagrams, link provided in the product documents section).

2. Indoor Unit Installation

1. **Choose Location:** Install the indoor unit in a convenient location inside the property, typically near the main entrance or in a central area.
2. **Mounting:** Securely mount the indoor unit to the wall using the provided hardware.
3. **Wiring:** Connect the wiring from the outdoor panel and the 12-V power adapter to the indoor unit. Double-check all connections.

3. Power Connection

- Plug the 12-V power adapter into a standard electrical outlet.
- Ensure all connections are secure before applying power.

OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

The Fermax 6201 intercom system is straightforward to operate:

Receiving a Call

1. When a visitor presses the call button on the outdoor panel, the indoor unit will ring.
2. Lift the handset on the indoor unit to establish two-way communication with the visitor.
3. To end the conversation, replace the handset on the indoor unit.

Opening the Door (if connected)

- During a conversation, press the door release button on the indoor unit to unlock the connected electric door strike or gate.

- The door will remain unlocked for a short period, allowing the visitor to enter.

MAINTENANCE

Regular maintenance ensures the longevity and optimal performance of your intercom system:

- **Cleaning:** The indoor unit and outdoor panel are easy to clean. Use a soft, damp cloth to wipe surfaces. Avoid abrasive cleaners or solvents.
- **Inspection:** Periodically check all visible wiring and connections for any signs of wear or damage.
- **Environmental Protection:** While the outdoor panel is designed for outdoor use, protecting it from extreme weather conditions (e.g., direct, prolonged exposure to heavy rain or snow) can extend its lifespan.

TROUBLESHOOTING

If you encounter issues with your Fermax 6201 intercom kit, refer to the following common problems and solutions:

| Problem | Possible Cause | Solution |
|--|---|--|
| No sound from indoor unit when call button is pressed. | No power to the unit; loose wiring connection; faulty outdoor panel button. | Check power adapter connection. Verify all wiring connections are secure. If problem persists, contact support. |
| Cannot hear visitor / Visitor cannot hear me. | Loose wiring; faulty speaker/microphone; handset not properly seated. | Check all wiring connections. Ensure handset is fully lifted. If problem persists, contact support. |
| Door release button does not work. | Incorrect wiring to electric lock; faulty door release mechanism; no power to lock. | Verify wiring to the electric lock. Ensure the lock receives power. Consult the installation manual for wiring diagrams. |
