Bovee 1000 Wireless Music Interface Adapter

INSTRUCTION MANUAL FOR AUDI, MERCEDES, AND VOLKSWAGEN

1. Overview

The Bovee 1000 is a wireless music interface adapter designed to bring Bluetooth audio streaming capabilities to compatible Audi, Mercedes, and Volkswagen vehicles equipped with a 30-pin iPod connector. This device offers a seamless plug-and-play experience, allowing users to stream music from their smartphone or other Bluetooth-enabled devices directly to their car's audio system. It supports displaying your iPod library on the car's screen and offers control via existing car controls.

Key Features:

- **Plug and Play:** No complex installation required.
- **Music Library Display:** View your iPod library on your car's display.
- **Airplay and A2DP Bluetooth Support:** High-quality wireless audio streaming.
- **Compatibility:** Designed for Audi AMI, Mercedes Media Interface, and VW MDI with 30-pin iPod connectors.

2. Setup

Follow these steps to set up your Bovee 1000 Wireless Music Interface Adapter:

1. **Locate Connector:** Find your car's AMI or MDI connector port. This is typically located in the glove box or center console.
2. **Connect Adapter:** Securely plug the Bovee 1000 adapter into the connector port.
3. **Ignition On:** Turn on your vehicle's ignition.
4. **Power Indicator:** Wait for the Bovee LED to light up, indicating it has power.
5. **Smartphone Pairing:**
 - Enable Bluetooth on your smartphone.
 - Search for "Bovee 1000" in the list of available Bluetooth devices.
 - Pair and connect. If prompted for a PIN, use 0000 or 1234.
6. **Start Music:** Once paired, open your preferred music application (e.g., Spotify, Apple Music) on your smartphone. Audio should now play through your car's sound system.

Important Notes:

- For Mercedes models, ensure the COMAND or Audio 20 system is active and not in AUX mode.
- For VW/Audi, select "Media Interface" or "External Audio Source" option in your car's menu.
- Avoid using extension cables; a direct connection is recommended for stable signal transmission.

3. Operating Instructions

Once the Bovee 1000 is successfully paired with your device, you can enjoy wireless music streaming and control through your car's existing system.

- **Music Playback:** Open any music streaming app on your paired smartphone. The audio will automatically route through your car's speakers.
- **Car Display Integration:** The adapter allows your car's display to show your entire iPod library from your iPhone, iPad, or iPod touch.
- **Steering Wheel Controls:** Utilize your car's steering wheel controls to safely skip tracks and adjust volume without distraction.
- **Automatic Reconnection:** The Bovee 1000 is designed to automatically reconnect to your paired device when you enter the vehicle, provided Bluetooth is enabled on your device.

4. Maintenance

The Bovee 1000 is designed for durability and requires minimal maintenance. Keep the device clean and dry. Avoid exposing it to extreme temperatures or moisture. Ensure the connection port in your vehicle is free from dust and debris to maintain optimal performance.

5. Troubleshooting

If you encounter issues with your Bovee 1000, refer to the following troubleshooting tips:

Problem	Solution
Blue light indicator does not come on when plugged in.	Unplug the cable from the car and plug it back in. If the unit still has no power, your cable or car's iPod installation may not be functioning properly. Older car models might require an additional 30-pin to 30-pin adapter to inject power.
Car will not recognize, phone is paired but will not play music.	1. Ensure car stereo is switched to AUX or iPod mode. Check your car's manual. 2. Download and save at least one song to your phone's library for the system to initialize communication. 3. Update your phone to the latest OS. Delete and unpair the device from your Bluetooth settings, restart your phone, then reconnect.
Cannot Pair with Phone.	Unplug from car and restart your phone. Turn off other Bluetooth devices. Plug back into car. When the blue light powers on and pairing indicator turns on, tap to pair on your phone (Pairing Code: 0000). If the unit loses power, unplug and replug until successful.
Music Quality is not good or music is skipping.	Unpair from car, delete and unpair the device from your Bluetooth devices, and update your phone to the latest OS. Restart your phone after the update, then reconnect and pair again.
My device was working but stopped connecting with my phone.	1. Disconnect from car and 'forget' the device from your Bluetooth settings. 2. Turn off Bluetooth on your phone and restart. 3. Go to Bluetooth settings and ensure Bluetooth is off. 4. Plug into the car and turn on Bluetooth. 5. Pair and connect to device using code 0000.
