- **Replacement:** V-belts are wear items and will eventually need replacement. The frequency depends on usage and operating conditions. Replace the belt if it shows signs of significant wear or damage, or if performance degrades.

6. TROUBLESHOOTING

If you experience issues with your mower's drive system, the V-belt may be a contributing factor. Here are some common problems and their potential solutions:

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Mower drive system slips or lacks power	Worn or stretched belt, incorrect belt tension, oil/grease on belt	Inspect belt for wear and replace if necessary. Adjust belt tension. Clean belt and pulleys.

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Belt breaks frequently	Excessive wear, improper installation, misaligned pulleys, foreign object interference	Replace belt. Ensure correct installation and routing. Check pulley alignment. Clear any obstructions.
Unusual noise from belt area	Worn belt, misaligned pulleys, worn bearings in pulleys	Inspect and replace worn belt. Check and correct pulley alignment. Inspect pulley bearings.
