The G303 features on-the-fly DPI switching, allowing you to adjust sensitivity from 200 to 12,000 DPI. Use the dedicated DPI cycle button (typically located behind the scroll wheel) to switch between up to 5 pre-set DPI levels. These levels can be customized within the Logitech Gaming Software.

- Ensure the software is running and the mouse profile is active.
