Cuisinart PL50E Elite BBQ Grill Instruction Manual

INTRODUCTION

Thank you for choosing the Cuisinart PL50E Elite BBQ Grill. This versatile appliance is designed for year-round use, offering a large cooking surface suitable for various meals. Its dual-zone temperature control allows for precise cooking, and the non-stick, PFOA-free plates ensure easy cleaning. Please read this manual thoroughly before first use to ensure safe and optimal operation.

IMPORTANT SAFETY INSTRUCTIONS

Always follow basic safety precautions when using electrical appliances to reduce the risk of fire, electric shock, and/or injury to persons.

- Read all instructions before operating the grill.
- Do not touch hot surfaces. Use handles or knobs.
- To protect against electrical hazards, do not immerse the cord, plugs, or the main unit in water or other liquids.
- Close supervision is necessary when any appliance is used by or near children.
- Unplug from outlet when not in use and before cleaning. Allow to cool before putting on or taking off parts.
- Do not operate any appliance with a damaged cord or plug, or after the appliance malfunctions or has been damaged in any manner.
- The use of accessory attachments not recommended by Cuisinart may cause injuries.
- Do not use outdoors.
- Do not let cord hang over edge of table or counter, or touch hot surfaces.
- Do not place on or near a hot gas or electric burner, or in a heated oven.
- Extreme caution must be used when moving an appliance containing hot oil or other hot liquids.
- Always attach plug to appliance first, then plug cord into the wall outlet. To disconnect, turn any

control to OFF, then remove plug from wall outlet.

- Do not use appliance for other than intended use.
- Ensure the drip tray is correctly inserted before operation.
- The non-stick coating is PFOA-free. Avoid using metal utensils that could scratch the surface.

PRODUCT OVERVIEW

The Cuisinart PL50E Elite BBQ Grill features a robust stainless steel construction and a large cooking area divided into two independent zones. Each zone is controlled by its own temperature dial, allowing for versatile cooking options.

Key components include:

- **Grill Plates:** Two interchangeable, non-stick cooking plates (one BBQ, one griddle) that are PFOA-free.
- **Temperature Control Dials:** Two independent dials for precise temperature adjustment for each cooking zone.
- **Drip Tray:** A removable tray located beneath the cooking plates to collect excess oil and fat.
- **Spatula:** A cleaning spatula is included for easy maintenance.

SETUP AND FIRST USE

1. **Unpack:** Carefully remove all packaging materials and any promotional labels or stickers from your

- grill.
2. **Clean Plates:** Before first use, wash the cooking plates and drip tray in warm, soapy water. Rinse thoroughly and dry completely. The plates and drip tray are also dishwasher safe.
 3. **Insert Drip Tray:** Slide the drip tray into its designated slot at the front of the grill base. Ensure it is fully inserted.
 4. **Install Plates:** Place the desired cooking plates onto the grill base. Ensure they are securely seated. The plates are designed for easy removal and re-clipping.
 5. **Position:** Place the grill on a stable, heat-resistant surface, away from walls or cabinets, ensuring adequate ventilation.
 6. **Power Connection:** Plug the power cord into a suitable 230V electrical outlet.

OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

The Cuisinart PL50E Elite BBQ Grill offers independent temperature control for its two cooking zones, allowing you to cook different foods simultaneously at their optimal temperatures.

1. **Preheat:** Turn the desired temperature control dial(s) to the desired setting. The indicator light will illuminate, signaling that the grill is heating. Allow 5-10 minutes for the grill to preheat thoroughly. The light will turn off when the set temperature is reached.
2. **Prepare Food:** Lightly brush the cooking plates with a small amount of cooking oil, if desired, especially for the first use or for foods prone to sticking.
3. **Place Food:** Carefully place food onto the preheated cooking plates. Avoid overcrowding the grill to ensure even cooking.
4. **Adjust Temperature:** Use the independent temperature dials to adjust heat as needed during cooking. For example, you can sear meat on one side and keep vegetables warm on the other.
5. **Monitor Cooking:** Cook food until desired doneness is achieved. The large cooking surface (23.5 x 33.5 cm per plate) accommodates various items.
6. **Remove Food:** Use heat-resistant, non-metal utensils to remove cooked food from the grill.
7. **Turn Off:** Once cooking is complete, turn both temperature control dials to the 'OFF' position and unplug the appliance from the wall outlet. Allow the grill to cool completely before cleaning.

CLEANING AND MAINTENANCE

Proper cleaning and maintenance will extend the life of your Cuisinart PL50E Elite BBQ Grill and ensure optimal performance.

1. **Cool Down:** Always ensure the grill is unplugged and completely cool before cleaning.
2. **Remove Drip Tray:** Carefully slide out the drip tray and discard any collected fat or liquids. Wash the drip tray in warm, soapy water or place it in the dishwasher.
3. **Remove Cooking Plates:** Press the plate release buttons (if applicable) and carefully lift the cooking plates from the base.
4. **Clean Cooking Plates:** The cooking plates are dishwasher safe. Alternatively, wash them by hand in warm, soapy water using a non-abrasive sponge or cloth. For stubborn residue, soak the plates before cleaning. Use the included cleaning spatula to gently scrape off food debris.

5. **Clean Base Unit:** Wipe the exterior of the grill base with a damp cloth. Do not use abrasive cleaners or immerse the base unit in water. Ensure no water enters the electrical components.
6. **Dry and Store:** Ensure all parts are thoroughly dry before reassembling or storing the grill. Store in a clean, dry place.

TROUBLESHOOTING

If you encounter any issues with your Cuisinart PL50E Elite BBQ Grill, please refer to the following common problems and solutions:

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Grill does not heat up.	Not plugged in; power outlet not working; temperature dial set to OFF.	Ensure the grill is securely plugged into a working outlet. Turn the temperature dial to a desired heat setting.
Food sticks to the plates.	Plates not preheated sufficiently; insufficient oil; damaged non-stick coating.	Allow grill to preheat fully. Lightly brush plates with cooking oil. Avoid using metal utensils that can damage the coating.
Uneven cooking.	Grill overcrowded; food not evenly distributed.	Avoid placing too much food on the grill at once. Distribute food evenly across the cooking surface.
Smoke production.	Excess fat/oil in drip tray; food residue on plates.	Empty and clean the drip tray regularly. Clean cooking plates thoroughly after each use. Ensure proper ventilation.
