1. INTRODUCTION

This manual provides detailed instructions for the proper installation and care of your Scag Turf Tiger Decal, Part # 483229. This decal is designed for specific Scag Turf Tiger models to maintain original equipment appearance and branding. Please read these instructions carefully before proceeding with installation.

3. INSTALLATION INSTRUCTIONS

Proper surface preparation is crucial for optimal decal adhesion and longevity. Follow these steps carefully:

- Clean the Surface:** Ensure the application surface on your Scag Turf Tiger is thoroughly clean, dry, and free of dust, grease, wax, or old adhesive residue. Use a mild detergent and water, then wipe with rubbing alcohol for best results. Allow the surface to dry completely.
- Position the Decal:** Carefully position the decal on the desired surface without removing the backing. Use masking tape to temporarily hold it in place and ensure proper alignment.
- Apply the Decal:**
 - Peel back a small section of the decal's backing paper from one edge.
 - Align the exposed edge of the decal with your desired position.
 - Slowly and steadily press the decal onto the surface, gradually peeling away the backing paper as you go. Use a squeegee or a credit card wrapped in a soft cloth to smooth out any air bubbles, working from the center outwards.
 - Once the entire decal is applied, firmly press over the entire surface to ensure good adhesion.
- Final Inspection:** Check for any remaining air bubbles. Small bubbles can often be pricked with a fine needle and smoothed out.

Note: Avoid applying the decal in direct sunlight or extreme temperatures. Ideal application temperature is between 60°F and 80°F (15°C and 27°C).

4. CARE AND CLEANING

To maintain the appearance and longevity of your Scag Turf Tiger Decal:

- **Gentle Cleaning:** Clean the decal with mild soap and water. Avoid harsh chemicals, abrasive cleaners, or high-pressure washers directly on the decal, as these can damage the finish or adhesive.
- **Avoid Scratches:** Do not use abrasive brushes or cloths that could scratch the decal surface.
- **Sun Exposure:** While designed for outdoor use, prolonged exposure to intense direct sunlight can eventually lead to fading.

5. TROUBLESHOOTING COMMON ISSUES

- **Decal Not Sticking:** Ensure the surface was thoroughly cleaned and dry before application. Residue from old adhesive, wax, or dirt can prevent proper adhesion. Re-clean the area and try again with a new decal if necessary.
- **Air Bubbles:** Small air bubbles can be pricked with a fine needle and smoothed out with a squeegee. For larger bubbles, carefully lift the nearest edge of the decal and reapply, smoothing as you go.
- **Peeling Edges:** If edges begin to peel, ensure the surface was clean and dry during application. Applying a thin layer of clear adhesive specifically designed for decals to the underside of the peeling edge may help.
