INTRODUCTION

The CooksEssentials 8 quart Digital Stainless Steel Pressure Cooker is designed to simplify your cooking process, allowing you to prepare flavorful and healthy meals in a fraction of the time compared to conventional methods. This appliance features an extra-large 8-quart capacity, 13 preset functions, a 24-hour delay timer, and an intuitive LED display screen. Its durable stainless steel construction and DuPont™ ScratchGuard® nonstick coating ensure long-lasting performance and easy cleaning. This manual provides essential information for safe operation and optimal performance.

IMPORTANT SAFEGUARDS

When using electrical appliances, basic safety precautions should always be followed, including the following:

- Read all instructions before operating the pressure cooker.
- Do not touch hot surfaces. Use handles or knobs.
- To protect against electrical shock, do not immerse cord, plugs, or heating base in water or other liquid.
- Close supervision is necessary when any appliance is used by or near children.
- Unplug from outlet when not in use and before cleaning. Allow to cool before putting on or taking off parts.
- Do not operate any appliance with a damaged cord or plug or after the appliance malfunctions or has been damaged in any manner.
- Do not use outdoors.
- Do not place on or near a hot gas or electric burner, or in a heated oven.
- Extreme caution must be used when moving an appliance containing hot oil or other hot liquids.
- Always attach plug to appliance first, then plug cord into the wall outlet. To disconnect, turn any control to "off", then remove plug from wall outlet.
- Do not use appliance for other than intended use.
- This appliance cooks under pressure. Improper use may result in scalding injury. Make certain unit is properly closed before operating.
- Do not fill the unit over 2/3 full. When cooking foods that expand during cooking, such as rice or dried vegetables, do not fill the unit over 1/2 full.
- Always check the pressure release valve and float valve for clogging before use.

PARTS AND FEATURES

Your CooksEssentials Pressure Cooker comes with several components designed for ease of use and versatility:

- **8-Quart Stainless Steel Pressure Cooker:** The main unit with a durable stainless steel exterior and a metal utensil-safe interior lined with DuPont™ ScratchGuard® nonstick coating.
- **Hinged Lid:** Designed for secure sealing during pressure cooking and easy access.
- **Measuring Cup:** For precise ingredient measurement.
- **Spoon:** A serving utensil.
- **LED Display Screen:** Provides clear visibility of cooking settings and countdown timer.
- **Control Panel:** Features 13 preset functions for various dishes, a 24-hour delay timer, and a 99-minute countdown timer.

SETUP: BEFORE FIRST USE

Before using your pressure cooker for the first time, follow these steps:

1. Unpack all components from the box.
2. Wash the removable inner pot, measuring cup, and spoon with warm, soapy water. Rinse thoroughly and dry completely.
3. Wipe the exterior of the pressure cooker base with a damp cloth. Do not immerse the base in water.
4. Ensure the sealing gasket is properly seated around the lid and the pressure release valve is clear.

OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

Operating your CooksEssentials Pressure Cooker is straightforward:

Basic Pressure Cooking

1. Place the inner pot into the pressure cooker base.
2. Add your ingredients and the required amount of liquid to the inner pot. Do not exceed the MAX fill line.
3. Close the hinged lid securely, ensuring it locks into place.
4. Plug the power cord into a grounded electrical outlet. The LED display will illuminate.
5. Select one of the 13 preset functions (e.g., Rice, Soup, Meat/Stew, Poultry, Beans/Chili, Fish, Vegetables, Sauté, Slow Cook, Steam, Keep Warm, Delay Timer, Manual).
6. Adjust the cooking time if necessary using the +/- buttons. The 99-minute countdown timer will begin once pressure is reached.
7. Once cooking is complete, the unit will automatically switch to the Keep Warm setting.
8. Carefully release pressure using the pressure release valve or allow it to naturally release before opening the lid.

Using the Delay Timer

The 24-hour delay timer allows you to program the cooker to start at a later time:

1. Prepare your ingredients and place them in the inner pot.
2. Close the lid and select your desired cooking function.
3. Press the "Delay Timer" button. Use the +/- buttons to set the desired delay time in hours.
4. The cooker will automatically begin the cooking cycle after the set delay time has elapsed.

CARE AND MAINTENANCE

Proper care ensures the longevity and performance of your pressure cooker:

- **Cleaning the Inner Pot:** The inner pot is dishwasher-safe. For hand washing, use warm, soapy water and a non-abrasive sponge. Rinse thoroughly and dry.
- **Cleaning the Lid:** Wash the lid, including the sealing gasket and pressure release valve, with warm, soapy water. Ensure all food particles are removed from the valve.
- **Cleaning the Base Unit:** Wipe the exterior of the pressure cooker base with a damp cloth. Never immerse the base unit in water or any other liquid.
- **Storage:** Ensure all parts are clean and dry before storing. Store the pressure cooker in a cool, dry place.

TROUBLESHOOTING

If you encounter issues with your pressure cooker, refer to the following common problems and solutions:

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Cooker not building pressure.	Lid not properly sealed; sealing gasket misplaced or damaged; insufficient liquid.	Ensure lid is fully closed and locked. Check gasket position and condition. Add more liquid if needed.
Steam leaking from lid.	Sealing gasket not seated correctly or damaged; food debris on rim.	Adjust gasket. Clean lid rim and gasket. Replace gasket if damaged.
Food not cooking properly.	Incorrect cooking time or pressure setting; insufficient liquid.	Refer to recipe for correct time/setting. Ensure adequate liquid for pressure to build.

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Error code on display.	Specific internal issue.	Unplug the unit, wait a few minutes, then plug back in. If error persists, contact customer support.
