## Product Overview

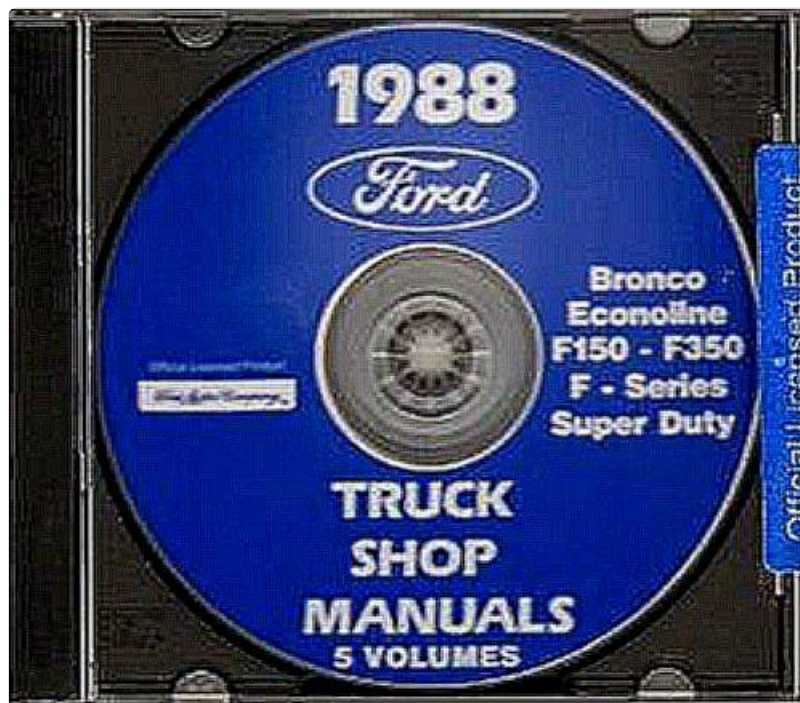


Image: Front cover of the 1988 Ford Pickup Truck Repair Shop Manual CD, showing the title and covered models.

## System Requirements

To ensure proper functionality and access to the manual's content, your computer system should meet the following minimum requirements:

- **Operating System:** Windows 98, ME, 2000, XP, Vista, 7, 8, 10 (Compatibility with newer OS versions may vary).
- **Processor:** Pentium II 300 MHz or higher.
- **RAM:** 128 MB or more.
- **Storage:** CD-ROM drive.
- **Display:** SVGA monitor with 800x600 resolution or higher.
- **Software:** Adobe Acrobat Reader (or compatible PDF viewer) for viewing PDF documents.

## Installation and Setup

---

Follow these steps to access the repair manual content from the CD-ROM:

1. **Insert the CD-ROM:** Place the "1988 Ford Pickup Truck Repair Shop Manual CD" into your computer's CD-ROM drive.
2. **Auto-run (if enabled):** If auto-run is enabled on your system, the CD's main menu or an installation prompt should appear automatically. Follow the on-screen instructions.
3. **Manual Access (if auto-run fails):** If the CD does not auto-run, navigate to "My Computer" or "This PC," locate your CD-ROM drive (e.g., D:), and double-click on the drive icon. Look for an executable file (e.g., "setup.exe", "start.exe", or "index.html") or a folder containing PDF files. Open the appropriate file to begin.
4. **Viewing Content:** The manual content is typically provided in PDF format. Ensure you have a PDF reader installed to view the documents.

**Note:** No permanent software installation is usually required for this type of manual CD; content is accessed directly from the disc.

## Navigating the Manual

---

Once the manual is open, utilize the features of your PDF reader for efficient navigation:

- **Table of Contents:** Most PDF readers display a navigable table of contents or bookmarks panel on the side. Use this to jump to specific sections like Engine, Transmission, Electrical, or Body.
- **Search Function:** Use the search function (usually Ctrl+F or Cmd+F) within your PDF reader to find specific keywords, part names, or diagnostic codes throughout the entire manual.
- **Zoom and Pan:** Adjust the zoom level to view diagrams and detailed illustrations clearly. Pan across pages as needed.
- **Printing:** Individual pages or entire sections can be printed for convenience during repair work.

## Troubleshooting (CD-ROM)
