PRODUCT OVERVIEW

The Razor DXT Drift Trike is engineered for downhill drifting action, allowing riders to experience freewheeling straights and tight curves. It features a full-size steel frame and moto-style construction, designed for durability and performance.

SAFETY INFORMATION

No specific warnings are applicable beyond general riding safety. Always wear appropriate safety gear, including a helmet, knee pads, and elbow pads. Ensure the riding area is clear of obstacles and traffic. This product is intended for ages 14 and up, with a maximum weight capacity of 198 pounds.

SETUP AND ASSEMBLY

The Razor DXT Drift Trike is designed for straightforward assembly. Most necessary tools are included. Follow the step-by-step instructions provided in the packaging for proper setup. Ensure all bolts and connections are securely tightened before initial use.

- **Frame Assembly:** Connect the main frame components.
- **Wheel Installation:** Attach the front wheel with its BMX-style platform pedals and alloy crank. Install the Super Slider POM rear wheels.
- **Handlebar Setup:** Secure the moto-style handlebars and pro-style grips. Connect the front brake cable.
- **Seat Adjustment:** Adjust the bucket-style seat to the rider's comfort and leg length. The seat offers multiple positions for varying rider sizes.
- **Accessory Attachment:** Attach the included tow hook and safety flag for increased visibility.

OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

The Razor DXT Drift Trike is designed for downhill drifting. To operate, sit firmly in the adjustable bucket seat and place your feet on the BMX-style platform pedals. Use the handlebars for steering and the front hand brake for control and initiating drifts.

Drifting Techniques:

- **Power Slide:** While moving, apply the front brake and turn the handlebars sharply in the desired direction to initiate a slide with the rear wheels.
- **Fish Tails:** Alternate quick turns and brake applications to create a side-to-side motion with the rear of the trike.
- **180s:** At speed, apply the front brake and turn the handlebars sharply to spin the trike 180 degrees.

MAINTENANCE

Regular maintenance ensures the longevity and safe operation of your Razor DXT Drift Trike.

- **Tire Pressure:** Regularly check and maintain the correct air pressure in the front tire for optimal steering and performance.
- **Brake Inspection:** Periodically inspect the front hand brake for proper function and adjust if necessary. Ensure the brake pads are not excessively worn.
- **Frame and Fasteners:** Check all bolts, nuts, and fasteners regularly to ensure they are tight. Tighten any loose components to prevent accidents.
- **Cleaning:** Clean the trike with a damp cloth after use to remove dirt and debris. Avoid using harsh chemicals that may damage the finish.
- **Storage:** Store the trike in a dry, covered area to protect it from the elements and prolong its lifespan.

TROUBLESHOOTING

If you encounter issues with your Razor DXT Drift Trike, refer to the following common troubleshooting tips:

- **Difficulty Pedaling:** Ensure the front wheel is properly inflated. Check for any obstructions around the pedals or chain.
- **Poor Drifting Performance:** Verify that the rear wheels are clean and free of debris. Ensure the riding surface is suitable for drifting (smooth, hard surfaces are ideal).
- **Loose Components:** If any parts feel loose, immediately stop using the trike and tighten all fasteners according to the assembly instructions.
- **Brake Issues:** If the brake is not responsive, check the cable tension and brake pad alignment. Adjust as needed or replace worn pads.
