1. Introduction

5. SETUP

5.1 Initial Charging

Before first use, fully charge the tablet for approximately 3-4 hours.

- 1. Connect the USB charging cable to the tablet's charging port.
- 2. Connect the other end of the USB cable to the power adapter.

- 3. Plug the power adapter into a wall outlet.
- 4. The battery icon on the screen will indicate charging status.

5.2 Powering On/Off

- **To Power On:** Press and hold the Power button (located on the top edge) for a few seconds until the screen lights up.
- To Power Off: Press and hold the Power button until a menu appears. Select 'Power off' and confirm.
- To Restart: Press and hold the Power button until a menu appears. Select 'Restart' and confirm.

5.3 Connecting to Wi-Fi

To access the internet and download apps, connect your tablet to a Wi-Fi network.

- 1. From the home screen, swipe down from the top to open the Quick Settings panel.
- 2. Tap and hold the Wi-Fi icon to open Wi-Fi settings.
- 3. Ensure Wi-Fi is toggled 'On'.
- 4. Select your desired Wi-Fi network from the list.
- 5. Enter the network password if prompted, then tap 'Connect'.

5.4 Initial Device Setup

Follow the on-screen prompts for initial setup, which typically includes:

- Language selection
- · Time zone and date settings
- Google account sign-in (required for Play Store access)
- · Accepting terms and conditions

6. OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

6.1 Basic Navigation

- Touch: Tap an icon to open an app or select an item.
- Swipe: Drag your finger across the screen to scroll through pages or lists.
- Pinch-to-Zoom: Use two fingers to zoom in or out on images and web pages.
- Home Button: Tap the circle icon at the bottom of the screen to return to the home screen.
- Back Button: Tap the triangle icon to go back to the previous screen.
- Recent Apps: Tap the square icon to view and switch between recently used applications.

6.2 App Management

- Downloading Apps: Open the Google Play Store app, search for desired apps, and tap 'Install'.
- **Uninstalling Apps:** Go to *Settings > Apps & notifications > See all apps* Select the app and tap 'Uninstall'.
- Organizing Apps: Drag and drop app icons on the home screen to rearrange them or create folders.

6.3 Parental Controls

The Android operating system offers built-in parental control features to manage content and screen time.

1. Google Family Link: Download the Google Family Link app on your own device and the child's

- tablet to set up comprehensive controls, including app approvals, screen time limits, and location tracking.
- 2. **Google Play Store Controls:** In the Play Store app, go to *Settings > Parental controls* to restrict content based on age ratings for apps, games, movies, and music.
- 3. **Digital Wellbeing:** Access *Settings > Digital Wellbeing & parental controls* to monitor usage and set app timers.

7. MAINTENANCE

7.1 Cleaning the Tablet

- Always power off the tablet and disconnect it from the charger before cleaning.
- Use a soft, lint-free cloth to gently wipe the screen and body.
- For stubborn marks, slightly dampen the cloth with water or a screen-safe cleaner. Avoid harsh chemicals.
- Clean the protective shell separately with mild soap and water if necessary, ensuring it is completely dry before reattaching.

7.2 Battery Care

- Avoid fully discharging the battery frequently. Charge it before it drops below 20%.
- Do not leave the tablet charging for extended periods after it reaches 100%.
- Store the tablet in a cool, dry place if not used for a long time, with the battery charged to about 50%.

7.3 Software Updates

Periodically check for software updates to ensure your tablet has the latest features and security patches. Go to Settings > System > Advanced > System update

8. TROUBLESHOOTING

If you encounter issues with your tablet, refer to the following common solutions:

Problem	Solution
Tablet will not power on	Ensure the battery is charged. Connect to the charger for at least 30 minutes, then try powering on again.
Cannot connect to Wi-Fi	Check if Wi-Fi is enabled in settings. Verify the Wi-Fi password. Restart your router and the tablet.
Apps are crashing or freezing	Close and reopen the app. Clear the app's cache (Settings > Apps & notifications > App info > Storage & cache > Clear cache). Restart the tablet.
Slow performance	Close unused apps. Clear cache for frequently used apps. Free up storage space by deleting unnecessary files.
Screen is unresponsive	Perform a forced restart by holding the Power button for about 10-15 seconds until the tablet restarts.
