INTRODUCTION

This manual provides instructions for the proper installation, operation, and maintenance of your BulbAmerica replacement projector lamp for the NEC M300XG projector. This product is designed to meet the original manufacturer's specifications for performance and compatibility.

SAFETY INFORMATION

- Always disconnect the projector from the power source before attempting any installation or maintenance.
- Allow the projector and the old lamp to cool down completely before handling. Hot lamps can cause burns.
- Avoid touching the glass surface of the new lamp bulb directly with bare hands. Oils from your skin can reduce lamp life. Use gloves or a clean cloth if necessary.
- Do not drop or subject the lamp to impact. Projector lamps contain high-pressure gas and can shatter if damaged.
- Dispose of old lamps according to local regulations, as they may contain mercury.

SETUP (LAMP INSTALLATION)

Follow these steps to replace the projector lamp in your NEC M300XG projector. Refer to your projector's user manual for specific instructions on accessing the lamp compartment.

1. **Power Off and Disconnect:** Ensure the projector is turned off and unplugged from the power outlet.
2. **Cool Down:** Allow the projector to cool for at least 30 minutes. The lamp operates at high temperatures.
3. **Locate Lamp Compartment:** Identify and open the lamp compartment cover on your NEC M300XG projector. This usually involves unscrewing a small panel.
4. **Remove Old Lamp:** Carefully loosen the screws securing the old lamp module in place. Gently pull

the handle on the lamp module to slide it out of the projector.

5. **Insert New Lamp:** Align the new BulbAmerica lamp module (Model NP15LP) with the slot in the projector. Slide it in firmly until it is fully seated.
6. **Secure New Lamp:** Tighten the screws to secure the new lamp module.
7. **Close Compartment:** Replace the lamp compartment cover and secure it with its screws.
8. **Reset Lamp Timer:** After installation, it is crucial to reset the lamp hour timer in your projector's menu. Consult your NEC M300XG projector manual for instructions on how to do this.

OPERATING CONSIDERATIONS

Once the new lamp is installed and the lamp timer is reset, you can resume normal projector operation. To maximize lamp life:

- Avoid frequent on/off cycles.
- Ensure adequate ventilation around the projector to prevent overheating.
- Allow the projector to complete its cool-down cycle before unplugging or moving it.

MAINTENANCE

Projector lamps generally require minimal maintenance beyond proper installation and operation. The primary maintenance task is timely replacement when the lamp reaches the end of its service life, indicated

by dimming or a lamp warning light on your projector.

- **Cleaning:** Do not attempt to clean the internal bulb of the lamp module. If the exterior housing is dusty, gently wipe it with a dry, soft cloth before installation.
- **Air Filter:** Regularly clean or replace your projector's air filter as recommended by NEC. A clogged filter can lead to overheating and reduced lamp life.

TROUBLESHOOTING

If you encounter issues after installing your new lamp, consider the following:

- **Lamp Not Lighting:**
 - Ensure the lamp module is fully seated and secured with its screws.
 - Verify the lamp compartment cover is closed properly and secured. Many projectors have a safety switch that prevents operation if the cover is open.
 - Check if the projector is receiving power.
- **Dim Image or Poor Color:**
 - Confirm the lamp timer was reset after installation.
 - Check projector settings for brightness or picture modes.
 - Ensure the projector lens is clean.
- **Lamp Warning Light Still On:**
 - This almost always indicates the lamp timer was not reset. Refer to your projector's manual for the reset procedure.
