Graco Freeport Classic Crib Instruction Manual

INTRODUCTION

Thank you for choosing the Graco Freeport Classic Crib. This crib is designed to provide a safe and comfortable sleeping environment for your child, transitioning from an infant crib to a toddler bed and daybed as your child grows. Please read this manual thoroughly before assembly and use to ensure proper setup and safe operation.

SAFETY INFORMATION

Your child's safety is our top priority. This crib meets all ASTM & CPSC safety standards and is JPMA Certified. Always follow these safety guidelines:

- **Assembly:** Ensure all parts are correctly assembled and all hardware is tightened securely before use. Periodically check all screws and bolts to ensure they remain tight.
- **Mattress:** Use only a mattress that is the correct size for this crib to prevent entrapment. The mattress platform adjusts to three different heights.
- **Weight Limit:** The maximum weight recommendation for this crib is 50 pounds. Discontinue use as a crib when your child begins to climb out or reaches 35 inches in height.
- **Stationary Side Rails:** This crib features stationary side rails for enhanced stability and safety.
- **Hazards:** Do not place the crib near windows where cords from blinds or drapes could strangle a child. Do not hang

toys or bags on the crib.

PARTS LIST

Before beginning assembly, verify that all components are present. A complete list of parts and hardware is included in the product packaging. If any parts are missing or damaged, do not proceed with assembly. Contact Graco customer support for assistance.

Typical components include:

- Front and Back End Panels
- Side Rails (Left and Right)
- Adjustable Mattress Support
- Hardware Pack (screws, bolts, barrel nuts, Allen wrench)

SETUP AND ASSEMBLY INSTRUCTIONS

Assembly of the Graco Freeport Classic Crib is required. Please follow the detailed, step-by-step instructions provided in the separate assembly guide included with your product. Ensure you have adequate space and the necessary tools (typically an Allen wrench, which is usually provided, and a Phillips head screwdriver).

1. Unpack all components and verify against the parts list.
2. Attach the side rails to the end panels using the provided hardware. Do not overtighten.
3. Install the mattress support at the desired height. Ensure it is securely fastened at all four corners.
4. Once fully assembled, double-check all connections to ensure they are tight and secure.

Note: For detailed visual instructions, refer to the assembly manual included in your product packaging.

OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

Adjusting Mattress Height

The Graco Freeport Classic Crib features a 3-position adjustable mattress support. To adjust the mattress height:

1. Remove the mattress from the crib.
2. Carefully remove the bolts securing the mattress support to the end panels.
3. Reposition the mattress support to the desired height level. Ensure all four corners are aligned with the corresponding holes.
4. Reinsert and securely tighten all bolts. Ensure the mattress support is level and stable before placing the mattress back in the crib.

Converting to Toddler Bed and Daybed

This crib is designed to convert into a toddler bed and a daybed, extending its usability as your child grows. Conversion kits (sold separately) may be required for these transformations. Refer to the specific conversion kit instructions for detailed steps.

- **Toddler Bed:** Typically involves removing the front side rail and replacing it with a shorter toddler guard rail.
- **Daybed:** Often involves removing the front side rail entirely, leaving the back and two end panels.

MAINTENANCE AND CARE

Proper care will help maintain the crib's appearance and extend its lifespan.

- **Cleaning:** Wipe with a dry cloth for general dusting. For spills or marks, wipe with a damp cloth. Avoid abrasive cleaners or strong chemicals that could damage the wood finish.
- **Hardware Checks:** Periodically check all screws, bolts, and other hardware to ensure they are tight. Loose hardware can compromise the crib's safety and stability.
- **Storage:** If storing the crib, ensure it is in a dry, temperature-controlled environment to prevent warping or damage to the wood.

TROUBLESHOOTING

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Crib feels wobbly or unstable.	Loose hardware.	Check and tighten all screws and bolts. Ensure all connections are secure.
Difficulty adjusting mattress height.	Bolts not fully removed or misaligned.	Ensure all bolts are completely removed before attempting to reposition. Align holes carefully when reinserting.
Parts do not fit together.	Incorrect orientation of parts or manufacturing defect.	Review assembly instructions to ensure parts are oriented correctly. If issue persists, contact customer support.
