INTRODUCTION

TROUBLESHOOTING

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Inaccurate Temperature Reading	Direct sunlight exposure; thermometer not fully acclimated to outdoor temperature.	Relocate the thermometer to a shaded area on the window. Allow 15-30 minutes for the thermometer to adjust to the ambient temperature.
Thermometer Not Sticking to Window	Window or thermometer surface is dirty; air bubbles trapped.	Clean both the window and the back of the thermometer thoroughly. Reapply, ensuring to smooth out any air bubbles.
Needle is Stuck or Not Moving	Physical obstruction or damage.	Gently tap the thermometer to dislodge any minor obstructions. If the issue persists, the unit may be damaged.
