Infanti CS8990 Lifestyle Car Seat Instruction Manual

Model: **CS8990** | Brand: **Infanti**

1. INTRODUCTION

The Infanti CS8990 Lifestyle Car Seat is designed to provide safety and comfort for children from birth up to 25 kg. This car seat adapts to your child's growth through two main stages, accommodating different weight groups and installation orientations. Please read this manual thoroughly before installation and use to ensure maximum safety for your child.

2. SAFETY INFORMATION

Your child's safety is paramount. Always ensure the car seat is securely installed according to the instructions for your child's weight and age. Improper installation can compromise safety. This car seat features a side impact protection system for enhanced safety.

- Never leave your child unattended in the car seat.
- Always secure your child with the 5-point harness system.
- Do not use the car seat if it has been involved in a vehicle crash, even if there is no visible damage.
- Follow the weight and age guidelines for each installation stage.

3. PRODUCT FEATURES

This car seat offers a range of features designed for your child's safety and comfort:

- Suitable for children from newborn up to 25 kg.
- Two stages of use: rear-facing (0-13 kg) and forward-facing (9-25 kg).
- Includes a lumbar cushion for newborns (up to 13 kg).
- Adjustable head support with 5 positions.
- 4 recline positions for optimal comfort.
- 5-point harness system, adjustable for growth.

- Padded shoulder adjustments for comfort.
- Integrated side impact protection system.
- Removable and washable cover for easy maintenance.
- Easy installation using the vehicle's seat belt.

4. SETUP AND INSTALLATION

Proper installation is crucial for your child's safety. Follow these steps carefully based on your child's weight and the required orientation.

4.1. Stage 1: Rear-Facing Installation (Newborn to 13 kg)

For infants from newborn up to 13 kg, the car seat must be installed in a rear-facing position. Use the included lumbar cushion for proper support.

1. Place the car seat on the vehicle seat in a rear-facing orientation.
2. Route the vehicle's lap and shoulder belt through the designated blue rear-facing belt path guides on the car seat base.
3. Buckle the vehicle's seat belt.
4. Press down firmly on the car seat while pulling the vehicle's seat belt tight to remove all slack.
5. Ensure the car seat does not move more than 1 inch (2.5 cm) side-to-side or front-to-back at the belt path.

4.2. Stage 2: Forward-Facing Installation (9 kg to 25 kg)

For children weighing 9 kg to 25 kg, install the car seat in a forward-facing position. For children 15 kg to 25 kg, the lumbar cushion can be removed.

1. Place the car seat on the vehicle seat in a forward-facing orientation.
2. Route the vehicle's lap and shoulder belt through the designated red forward-facing belt path guides on the car seat.
3. Buckle the vehicle's seat belt.
4. Use your body weight to compress the car seat into the vehicle seat while pulling the vehicle's seat belt tight to remove all slack.
5. Ensure the car seat does not move more than 1 inch (2.5 cm) side-to-side or front-to-back at the belt path.

5. OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

Once installed, follow these steps to properly use the car seat and secure your child.

5.1. Adjusting the Head Support

The head support can be adjusted to 5 different positions to accommodate your child's height. Locate the adjustment lever at the top of the headrest and slide it up or down until it clicks into the desired position. Ensure the shoulder straps are at the correct height for your child (at or just below shoulders for rear-facing, at or just above shoulders for forward-facing).

5.2. Adjusting Recline Positions

The car seat offers 4 recline positions for optimal comfort. Use the recline lever, typically located at the front or side of the base, to select the desired angle. Ensure the car seat is not reclined too far forward when forward-facing, and that the recline angle is appropriate for rear-facing infants.

5.3. Securing Your Child

1. Place your child in the car seat, ensuring their back is flat against the seat back.
2. Bring the two buckle tongues together and insert them into the crotch buckle until they click.
3. Pull the harness adjustment strap, usually located at the front of the car seat, to tighten the harness until it is snug against your child's body. You should not be able to pinch any slack in the harness straps at the shoulder.
4. Ensure the chest clip is positioned at armpit level.

6. MAINTENANCE

Regular maintenance helps prolong the life of your car seat and ensures continued safety.

- **Cleaning the Cover:** The car seat cover is removable and washable. Refer to the care label attached to the cover for specific washing instructions. Typically, it requires a gentle cycle with cold water and air drying. Do not use bleach or harsh detergents.
- **Cleaning the Harness:** Wipe harness straps with a damp cloth. Do not machine wash or submerge harness straps in water, as this can weaken the webbing.
- **Cleaning Plastic Parts:** Wipe plastic parts with a damp cloth and mild soap.
- **Inspection:** Periodically inspect the harness straps, buckles, and plastic components for any signs of wear, fraying, cracks, or damage. If any damage is found, discontinue use and contact customer support.
- **Crash Replacement:** Replace the car seat if it has been involved in a crash, even if there is no visible damage, as its structural integrity may be compromised.

7. TROUBLESHOOTING

Here are solutions to common issues you might encounter:

- **Car Seat Feels Loose After Installation:** Ensure the vehicle's seat belt is pulled as tightly as possible. For rear-facing, press down firmly on the car seat while tightening the belt. For forward-facing, use your body weight to compress the car seat into the vehicle seat while tightening. Check that the belt is routed correctly through the designated path.
- **Harness Straps are Difficult to Adjust:** Check for any twists in the harness straps behind the car seat. Ensure the harness adjustment strap is not obstructed and moves freely.
- **Child's Head Slumps Forward (Forward-Facing):** This can occur with some car seat and vehicle seat combinations. Ensure the car seat is in the most reclined forward-facing position allowed. If the issue persists, consult a certified car seat technician.
