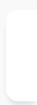

# SOBO WP-800M Super Wave Maker Aquarium Pump Instruction Manual

Model: WP-800M



## 1. INTRODUCTION

The SOBO WP-800M Super Wave Maker is designed to create natural water currents within your aquarium, promoting a healthier environment for aquatic life. This device helps circulate water, distribute nutrients, and prevent stagnant areas, which is crucial for the well-being of fish and corals. Please read this manual thoroughly before installation and operation to ensure proper use and longevity of the product.

## 2. SAFETY INSTRUCTIONS

To prevent injury or damage to the product, always observe the following safety precautions:

- Always disconnect the power supply before performing any maintenance, installation, or removal of the wave maker from the aquarium.
- Ensure your hands are dry before plugging in or unplugging the power cord.
- Do not operate the wave maker if the power cord or plug is damaged.
- This device is intended for indoor use in aquariums only. Do not use it for any other purpose.
- Keep the power cord away from sharp objects and hot surfaces.
- Ensure the wave maker is fully submerged in water during operation. Running it dry can cause damage.

- Do not attempt to disassemble or repair the unit yourself. Refer to qualified personnel for service.

### 3. PRODUCT COMPONENTS

The SOBO WP-800M Super Wave Maker typically includes the following components:

- Wave Maker Pump Unit
- Suction Cup Mount
- Power Cord with Plug

### 4. INSTALLATION AND SETUP

Follow these steps to properly install your SOBO WP-800M Super Wave Maker:

1. **Unpack:** Carefully remove all components from the packaging. Inspect for any damage.
2. **Placement:** Select an appropriate location within your aquarium. The wave maker should be placed where it can create optimal water flow without directly blasting sensitive corals or fish. Consider placing it near the top or middle of the tank, directed towards open areas.
3. **Secure:** Attach the wave maker to the aquarium glass using the provided suction cup mount. Ensure the suction cups are clean and firmly pressed against the glass to prevent the unit from detaching.
4. **Submerge:** Ensure the entire wave maker pump unit is fully submerged in water before connecting to power.
5. **Connect Power:** Once securely placed and submerged, connect the power cord to a suitable electrical outlet.

### 5. OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

Once installed and powered on, the SOBO WP-800M Super Wave Maker will begin to operate, generating water movement within your aquarium. The device is designed for continuous operation to maintain consistent water circulation.

- **Initial Start-up:** After plugging in, the pump will start immediately. Observe the water flow pattern and adjust the position of the wave maker if necessary to achieve desired circulation.
- **Flow Direction:** The direction of the water flow can be adjusted by carefully rotating the pump unit on its mount.
- **Continuous Operation:** For optimal aquarium health, the wave maker is typically run continuously.

## 6. MAINTENANCE

Regular maintenance ensures the efficient and long-lasting performance of your wave maker.

- Disconnect Power:** Always unplug the wave maker from the power outlet before performing any maintenance.
- Remove from Tank:** Carefully remove the wave maker from the aquarium.
- Clean Impeller:** The impeller is the rotating part that creates water flow. Over time, it can accumulate debris, algae, or mineral deposits. Gently remove the front cover and then the impeller. Clean the impeller and its housing with a soft brush and clean water. Avoid using harsh chemicals.
- Clean Housing:** Wipe down the exterior of the pump unit and the suction cup mount.
- Reassemble:** Carefully reassemble the impeller and cover. Ensure all parts are correctly seated.
- Reinstall:** Place the cleaned wave maker back into the aquarium and reconnect power.

Perform this cleaning routine monthly or as needed, depending on the accumulation of debris in your aquarium.

## 7. TROUBLESHOOTING

If you encounter issues with your SOBO WP-800M Super Wave Maker, refer to the following common problems and solutions:

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Wave maker does not start	No power supply Impeller jammed	Check power connection and outlet Disconnect power, remove and clean impeller
Weak water flow	Impeller dirty or obstructed Unit not fully submerged	Disconnect power, clean impeller and housing Ensure wave maker is completely underwater

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Excessive noise or vibration	Impeller damaged or unbalanced Debris in impeller housing Improper mounting	Disconnect power, inspect impeller for damage, clean thoroughly Ensure suction cups are firmly attached to the glass
