# Candy FPE 609A/6X Electric Oven User Manual

Model: FPE609A/6

## 1. INTRODUCTION AND SAFETY INFORMATION

This manual provides essential information for the safe and efficient operation of your new Candy FPE 609A/6X electric oven. Please read these instructions carefully before installation and use, and keep them for future reference. Proper installation, use, and maintenance are crucial for optimal performance and safety.

### 1.1 Important Safety Warnings

- **Electrical Safety:** Ensure the oven is correctly earthed and connected to a suitable power supply. Do not use adapters or extension cords. Disconnect from power before any cleaning or maintenance.
- **Hot Surfaces:** The oven and its accessible parts become very hot during use. Always use oven mitts when handling hot items or surfaces. Keep children and pets away from the appliance.
- **Ventilation:** Ensure adequate ventilation around the oven as specified in the installation instructions to prevent overheating.
- **Cleaning:** Clean the oven regularly to prevent the build-up of grease and food residues, which can pose a fire hazard.
- **Supervision:** This appliance is not intended for use by persons (including children) with reduced physical, sensory or mental capabilities, or lack of experience and knowledge, unless they have been given supervision or instruction concerning use of the appliance by a person responsible for their safety.

## 2. INSTALLATION AND SETUP

The Candy FPE 609A/6X is a built-in electric oven designed for integration into kitchen cabinetry. For safe and correct operation, professional installation by a qualified technician is highly recommended.

### 2.1 Unpacking and Inspection

Carefully remove all packaging materials. Inspect the oven for any signs of damage during transit. Do not install a damaged appliance. Retain packaging for potential future transport or service.

### 2.2 Positioning and Ventilation

Ensure the cabinet opening dimensions match the oven's specifications. Adequate ventilation must be provided around the oven to allow for proper heat dissipation. Refer to the detailed installation diagram provided with the physical product for precise measurements and clearances.

## 2.3 Electrical Connection

The oven must be connected to the mains electricity supply by a qualified electrician, following local wiring regulations. Ensure the voltage and frequency ratings on the oven's rating plate match your household supply.

## 3. OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

Your Candy FPE 609A/6X oven features intuitive controls for various cooking functions. Familiarize yourself with the control panel before first use.

### 3.1 Control Panel Overview

The control panel consists of two rotary knobs and a central digital display with touch controls.

- **Left Rotary Knob:** Temperature selection (ranging from 50°C to 250°C, with a 'MAX' setting).
- **Right Rotary Knob:** Cooking function selection (e.g., Conventional, Grill, Fan Assisted, Defrost).
- **Digital Display:** Shows time, cooking duration, and various indicators. It also features touch buttons for setting the timer, clock, and other functions.

### 3.2 Setting the Clock

Upon first connection to power, the display will flash. Use the touch controls below the digital display to set the current time. Refer to the specific icons on your display for 'set' or 'adjust' functions.

### 3.3 Selecting a Cooking Function and Temperature

1. Turn the **Right Rotary Knob** to select the desired cooking function (e.g., Fan Assisted for even baking, Grill for browning).
2. Turn the **Left Rotary Knob** to set the desired cooking temperature. The oven will begin to heat up.
3. The oven will indicate when the set temperature is reached (e.g., an indicator light turning off or a sound signal).

### 3.4 Using the Timer

The digital display allows you to set a cooking duration or a delayed start. Consult the specific icons on your display for timer settings. Typically, you press a timer button, then use the '+' and '-' touch controls to adjust the time.

## 4. MAINTENANCE AND CLEANING

Regular cleaning and maintenance will ensure the longevity and optimal performance of your oven.

### 4.1 General Cleaning

- **Before Cleaning:** Always ensure the oven is cool and disconnected from the power supply.
- **Exterior:** Wipe the exterior surfaces with a soft cloth dampened with warm soapy water. Avoid abrasive cleaners or scourers that can damage the metallic finish.
- **Interior:** For light soiling, wipe the interior with a damp cloth after each use. For stubborn stains, use a specialized oven cleaner, following the product's instructions carefully. Ensure adequate ventilation during and after cleaning.
- **Oven Racks and Accessories:** These can be removed and washed in warm soapy water or in a dishwasher.

### 4.2 Replacing the Oven Light

Ensure the oven is cool and disconnected from the power supply. Unscrew the protective glass cover, replace the bulb with a new one of the same type (check specifications for bulb type), and reattach the cover.

## 5. TROUBLESHOOTING

Before contacting customer service, please refer to the following common issues and their potential solutions.

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Oven does not heat up.	No power supply; incorrect function/temperature selected; fuse tripped.	Check power connection and circuit breaker. Ensure function and temperature knobs are correctly set.

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Digital display is blank.	Power outage; oven not connected to power.	Check power supply. If recently connected, set the clock.
Food not cooking evenly.	Incorrect rack position; oven door not fully closed; excessive food in oven.	Use recommended rack positions. Ensure door is sealed. Avoid overcrowding the oven.
Excessive smoke during cooking.	Food spills; grease build-up; high fat content food.	Clean the oven interior thoroughly. Use a baking tray to catch drips.
