1. SAFETY INSTRUCTIONS

Please read these instructions carefully before operating the BONECO Air Purifier P500. Failure to follow these instructions may result in electric shock, fire, or serious injury.

- Always place the appliance on a firm, level surface.
- · Do not block air inlets or outlets.
- · Keep the appliance away from water and moisture.
- Unplug the appliance before cleaning or performing any maintenance.
- Do not operate the appliance with a damaged cord or plug.
- This appliance is not intended for use by persons (including children) with reduced physical, sensory or mental capabilities, or lack of experience and knowledge, unless they have been given supervision or instruction concerning use of the appliance by a person responsible for their safety.

2. PRODUCT OVERVIEW

The BONECO Air Purifier P500 is designed to provide clean and healthy indoor air by filtering out ultrafine particles. It features a multi-stage filtration system, including HEPA and active carbon filters, to effectively remove various airborne contaminants.

3. SETUP

Follow these steps to set up your BONECO Air Purifier P500:

- 1. Unpack the Appliance: Carefully remove the air purifier and all packaging materials from the box.
- 2. **Remove Filter Packaging:** Open the filter compartment and remove the protective plastic packaging from the A501 filter.
- 3. **Install Filter:** Insert the A501 filter back into the compartment, ensuring it is seated correctly. Close the filter compartment cover securely.
- 4. **Position the Appliance:** Place the air purifier on a stable, level surface in the desired room. Ensure there is adequate space around the unit for proper airflow (at least 8 inches from walls or furniture).
- 5. Connect to Power: Plug the power cord into a suitable electrical outlet.

4. OPERATING THE AIR PURIFIER

The BONECO Air Purifier P500 offers several operating modes and functions for optimal air quality management.

4.1 Power On/Off

Press the power button on the control panel or remote control to turn the unit on or off.

4.2 Operation Modes

- Auto Mode: The purifier automatically adjusts fan speed based on detected air quality.
- **Sleep Mode:** Operates at a lower fan speed with reduced display brightness for quiet night-time operation.
- Power Mode: Activates maximum fan speed for rapid air purification.

4.3 Timer Function

Use the timer button to set the desired operating duration. The unit will automatically turn off after the set time.

4.4 Air Quality Indicator

The display provides real-time feedback on the current air quality in your environment.

4.5 Fragrance Tray

To use essential oils, open the fragrance tray, add a few drops of your preferred oil to the felt pad, and close the tray. The purified air will then be blended with the aroma.

5. MAINTENANCE

Regular maintenance ensures the longevity and optimal performance of your BONECO Air Purifier P500.

5.1 Filter Change Reminder

The appliance will indicate when it is time to change the A501 filter. This reminder ensures continuous clean air delivery.

5.2 Filter Replacement

When the filter change indicator illuminates:

- 1. Unplug the air purifier from the power outlet.
- 2. Open the filter compartment cover.
- 3. Remove the used A501 filter.
- 4. Insert a new A501 filter, ensuring correct orientation.
- 5. Close the filter compartment cover securely.
- 6. Plug the unit back in and reset the filter reminder according to the instructions in the full manual (typically by pressing and holding a specific button).

5.3 Cleaning the Appliance

- Wipe the exterior of the unit with a soft, damp cloth. Do not use abrasive cleaners or solvents.
- The pre-filter (if applicable and removable) can be gently cleaned with a vacuum cleaner or rinsed with water. Ensure it is completely dry before reinserting.

6. TROUBLESHOOTING

If you encounter issues with your BONECO Air Purifier P500, refer to the following common solutions:

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Unit does not turn on	No power supply; power cord not plugged in; unit not assembled correctly.	Check power connection; ensure filter compartment is closed properly.
Poor air purification	Filter is dirty or expired; air inlets/outlets blocked; room size too large.	Replace filter; clear obstructions; ensure unit is suitable for room size.
Unusual noise	Foreign object in fan; unit not on a stable surface; filter not installed correctly.	Unplug and check for obstructions; place on a flat surface; re-install filter.

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Filter change indicator remains on after replacement	Filter reminder not reset.	Refer to the full manual for instructions on resetting the filter reminder.
