INTRODUCTION

This manual provides detailed instructions for the installation, operation, and maintenance of your COMFAST CF-WP500M 500Mbps HomePlug AV Powerline Network Adapters. Please read this manual thoroughly before using the product to ensure proper setup and optimal performance. These adapters allow you to extend your internet connection using your home's existing electrical wiring, providing a stable and high-speed network connection without new cables.

PRODUCT OVERVIEW

The COMFAST CF-WP500M is a compact HomePlug AV powerline adapter designed for easy network extension. Each adapter features LED indicators for status monitoring and an RJ45 Ethernet port for device connectivity.

LED Indicators:

- Power LED (≶):
 - on: Device is powered on.
 - o Off: Device is powered off.
- Powerline LED ():
 - On: Connected to a powerline network.
 - Flashing: Data transmission over the powerline network.
 - Off: Not connected to a powerline network.
- Ethernet LED ():
 - On: Ethernet port is connected to a device.
 - Flashing: Data transmission over the Ethernet port.
 - o Off: No Ethernet connection.

SETUP

Follow these steps to set up your COMFAST CF-WP500M Powerline Network Adapters:

- 1. **Connect the First Adapter:** Plug one powerline adapter directly into a wall electrical outlet near your internet router. Avoid power strips or surge protectors as they can interfere with performance.
- 2. **Connect to Router:** Use one of the provided Ethernet cables to connect the powerline adapter's RJ45 port to an available LAN port on your internet router.
- 3. **Connect the Second Adapter:** Plug the second powerline adapter directly into a wall electrical outlet in the room where you need network access.

- 4. **Connect to Device:** Use the second Ethernet cable to connect the second powerline adapter's RJ45 port to your computer, smart TV, game console, or other network-enabled device.
- 5. **Verify Connection:** Wait for the Powerline LED on both adapters to turn solid green. This indicates a successful powerline connection. The Ethernet LED should also be on or flashing if a device is connected and active.
- 6. Pairing (Optional, for Security or New Devices): If the adapters do not connect automatically or if you wish to secure your network, press the 'Pair' button (if available, typically a small button on the side or bottom) on one adapter for 1-2 seconds, then within two minutes, press the 'Pair' button on the second adapter for 1-2 seconds. The Powerline LED will flash during pairing and become solid when successful.

OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

Once set up, your powerline network operates automatically. The adapters will establish a connection through your home's electrical wiring, extending your network.

- Network Access: Any device connected via Ethernet to the second powerline adapter will have direct access to your internet and local network.
- **Performance:** For optimal performance, ensure adapters are plugged directly into wall outlets. Avoid outlets controlled by a wall switch if continuous operation is desired.
- Adding More Adapters: To expand your powerline network, purchase additional COMFAST HomePlug AV compatible adapters and follow the pairing instructions.

MAINTENANCE

Proper maintenance ensures the longevity and performance of your powerline adapters:

- Cleaning: Gently wipe the adapters with a dry, soft cloth. Do not use liquid cleaners or aerosols.
- **Placement:** Keep adapters in well-ventilated areas. Avoid covering them or placing them near heat sources.
- Environmental Conditions: Operate the adapters within their specified temperature and humidity ranges.
- Firmware Updates: Check the COMFAST official website periodically for any available firmware updates for your model.

TROUBLESHOOTING

If you encounter issues, refer to the following common problems and solutions:

• No Power LED:

- Ensure the adapter is securely plugged into a working electrical outlet.
- Test the outlet with another device.

· Powerline LED is Off:

- Ensure both adapters are plugged into wall outlets on the same electrical circuit.
- Avoid power strips, surge protectors, or extension cords.
- Try plugging the adapters into different outlets.

• Perform the pairing process as described in the Setup section.

• Ethernet LED is Off:

- Check the Ethernet cable connection between the adapter and your device/router.
- Ensure the connected device is powered on and functioning correctly.
- Try a different Ethernet cable.

• Slow Network Speed:

- Ensure adapters are plugged directly into wall outlets, not power strips.
- Large electrical appliances (e.g., washing machines, refrigerators) on the same circuit can cause interference. Try moving adapters to different outlets.
- Check the quality of your home's electrical wiring. Older or faulty wiring can impact performance.
