## 1. INTRODUCTION

### 3. SETUP INSTRUCTIONS

---

## Connecting the Hard Drive

1. Locate an available USB 3.0 port on your computer. While compatible with USB 2.0 ports, using a USB 3.0 port ensures optimal transfer speeds.
2. Connect the small end of the provided USB 3.0 cable to the port on the Verbatim Store 'n' Go hard drive.
3. Connect the larger end of the USB 3.0 cable to the USB 3.0 port on your computer.
4. The hard drive will be automatically detected by your operating system (Windows or Mac). A new drive letter or icon will appear in 'My Computer' (Windows) or on the 'Desktop'/'Finder' (Mac).

## Initial Use and Software

The Verbatim Store 'n' Go hard drive comes pre-formatted and ready for immediate use. It may include pre-loaded software such as the Green Button energy-saving utility. You can install this software from the drive if desired, following the on-screen prompts.

## 4. OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

---

### Transferring Files

To transfer files to or from the Verbatim Store 'n' Go hard drive:

- **Drag and Drop:** Open the folder containing the files you wish to transfer. Open the Verbatim drive in another window. Drag the desired files or folders from your computer to the Verbatim drive, or vice versa.
- **Copy and Paste:** Select the files or folders you wish to transfer. Right-click (or Control-click on Mac) and select 'Copy'. Navigate to the destination (either on your computer or the Verbatim drive), right-click in an empty space, and select 'Paste'.

The USB 3.0 interface ensures rapid data transfer for large files and extensive backups.

### Safely Removing the Hard Drive

Always safely remove the hard drive before disconnecting it to prevent data corruption.

- **Windows:** Click the 'Safely Remove Hardware and Eject Media' icon in the system tray (bottom-right corner of the screen). Select the Verbatim drive and wait for the 'Safe to Remove Hardware' message.
- **Mac:** Drag the hard drive icon from your Desktop or Finder sidebar to the Trash icon. Alternatively, right-click (or Control-click) the drive icon and select 'Eject'. Wait for the icon to disappear before disconnecting.

## 5. MAINTENANCE

---

### Physical Care

- Avoid dropping or subjecting the drive to strong impacts.
- Keep the drive away from extreme temperatures, direct sunlight, and moisture.
- Clean the exterior with a soft, dry cloth. Do not use liquid cleaners.

### Data Management

- Regularly back up important data from your computer to the Verbatim drive, and consider backing up critical data from the Verbatim drive to another location.
- Periodically check the drive for errors using your operating system's disk utility tools.

## Energy Saving

Utilize the included Green Button software to manage the drive's power consumption. This software can automatically put the drive into sleep mode after a period of inactivity, conserving energy and extending the drive's lifespan.

## 6. TROUBLESHOOTING

---

### Drive Not Detected

- Ensure the USB cable is securely connected to both the drive and the computer.
- Try connecting the drive to a different USB port on your computer.
- If using a desktop computer, try a USB port on the back of the computer, as these often provide more stable power.
- Restart your computer and try connecting the drive again.
- Check your computer's 'Disk Management' (Windows) or 'Disk Utility' (Mac) to see if the drive is recognized but not assigned a drive letter or mounted.

### Slow Data Transfer Speeds

- Ensure the drive is connected to a USB 3.0 port on your computer. Connecting to a USB 2.0 port will result in significantly slower speeds.
- Verify that your computer's USB 3.0 drivers are up to date.
- Avoid running multiple demanding applications during large file transfers.
- Check the health of the drive using disk utility software.

### Data Corruption

- Always safely eject the drive before disconnecting it.
- Ensure the drive is not exposed to power fluctuations.
- Run a disk check or repair utility provided by your operating system.
