1. PRODUCT OVERVIEW

The Donco Kids Study & Sleep Twin Cappuccino Low Loft Bed is designed to maximize space in children's bedrooms. This multi-functional furniture piece integrates a comfortable twin-sized sleeping area with a built-in study desk, a 3-drawer chest, and a bookcase, all finished in a rich dark cappuccino. Its thoughtful design provides a dedicated space for sleeping, studying, and storage, making it an ideal solution for smaller rooms.

2. SAFETY INFORMATION

- This bed meets or surpasses ASTM/CPSC standards, ensuring a secure environment.
- Maximum weight limit for the bed is 200 pounds.
- Always ensure all hardware is securely tightened before use. Periodically check and re-tighten as needed.
- Do not use power tools for assembly unless specifically instructed, as this may damage the wood and void warranty.
- Ensure the bed is placed on a level surface.
- Keep small children away from the assembly area during setup.
- Only use a standard twin-size mattress. Mattress thickness should not exceed 8 inches to maintain guardrail effectiveness.

- The desk and bookcase components can be configured to suit your room layout and preferences.

5. OPERATING AND USAGE

The Donco Kids Low Loft Bed is designed for versatile use in a child's room.

5.1 Integrated Study Desk

The study desk is designed to slide in and out from under the bed. When extended, it provides a convenient surface for homework, drawing, or other activities. When not in use, it can be pushed back to save space. A chair can be placed in front of the desk when extended.

The 3-drawer chest offers ample storage for clothing or other items. The integrated bookcase provides shelves for books, toys, or decorative items. The space underneath the bed, particularly when the desk is pushed in, can also be utilized for additional storage or as a play area.

6. MAINTENANCE

To maintain the appearance and longevity of your Donco Kids Low Loft Bed, regularly wipe surfaces with a dry, soft cloth. Avoid using harsh chemicals or abrasive cleaners, as these may damage the finish. Periodically check all screws and fasteners to ensure they remain tight and secure.

7. TROUBLESHOOTING

7.1 Common Issues and Solutions

Issue	Possible Cause	Solution
Drawers getting stuck or not closing smoothly.	Improper assembly of drawer slides or drawer box; obstruction in the drawer path.	Review the assembly instructions for the dresser drawers. Ensure all slides are correctly aligned and free of debris. Reassemble if necessary.
Missing or misaligned pre-drilled holes.	Manufacturing inconsistency.	If a part has misaligned or missing pre-drilled holes that prevent proper assembly, contact Donco Kids customer support for a replacement part. Do not attempt to force screws or drill new holes without guidance.
Bed frame feels wobbly or shakes.	Loose fasteners; uneven floor surface.	Ensure all screws and bolts are securely tightened. If the issue persists, check if the bed is on a level surface and adjust as needed.
