### 1. PRODUCT OVERVIEW

The nanoblock Budgie Green Opaline building kit allows you to construct a detailed miniature model of a budgerigar, also known as a parakeet. This kit is part of the Birds Collection Series and features the distinctive green plumage and pink beak characteristic of the Australian Budgie. It provides a unique building experience with micro-sized blocks, resulting in an intricate and display-ready model.

## 2. SAFETY INFORMATION

**WARNING: This product contains small parts which may pose a choking hazard. Not suitable for children under 3 years. Recommended age for assembly is 15 years and up due to the small size of the blocks.**

Always keep small parts away from young children and pets. Ensure all components are securely connected during assembly to prevent accidental detachment.

## 3. WHAT'S IN THE BOX

Your nanoblock Budgie Green Opaline building kit includes:

- nanoblock - Budgerigar Green Opaline [Birds] micro-sized building blocks (approximately 80 pieces).
- Detailed assembly instructions.

## 4. SETUP AND ASSEMBLY

Follow these general steps to assemble your nanoblock Budgie Green Opaline model:

1. **Unpack Components:** Carefully open the packaging and empty all micro blocks onto a clean, flat surface. It is advisable to use a tray or container to prevent loss of small pieces.
2. **Review Instructions:** Familiarize yourself with the included step-by-step assembly guide. Pay attention to the color and shape of the blocks for each step.
3. **Begin Construction:** Start building from the base of the model as indicated in the instructions. Connect the micro blocks firmly. Due to their small size, a pair of tweezers (not included) may be helpful for precise placement.
4. **Layer by Layer:** Proceed with assembly layer by layer, ensuring each block is correctly aligned and pressed into place. The instructions will guide you through the formation of the budgie's body, wings, head, and beak.
5. **Final Touches:** Once all blocks are connected, double-check the stability and appearance of your completed model.

## 5. OPERATING AND DISPLAY

Once assembled, your nanoblock Budgie Green Opaline model is ready for display. It is designed as a static display piece. Place it on a stable, flat surface where it can be admired without risk of falling or being disturbed. Avoid areas with high vibration or direct sunlight to preserve the block colors.

## 6. MAINTENANCE

To maintain the appearance of your nanoblock model:

- **Cleaning:** Gently dust the model with a soft brush or a can of compressed air to remove accumulated dust. For more stubborn dirt, a slightly damp cloth can be used, but avoid excessive moisture.
- **Storage:** If disassembling for storage, keep all blocks in a sealed container to prevent loss and protect them

from dust and damage.

- **Avoid Harsh Chemicals:** Do not use abrasive cleaners or solvents, as these can damage the plastic blocks and their colors.

## 7. TROUBLESHOOTING

If you encounter issues during or after assembly:

- **Missing Pieces:** Carefully re-check the packaging and your work area. Due to the small size, blocks can be easily overlooked. If a piece is genuinely missing, contact the manufacturer's customer support.
- **Difficulty Connecting Blocks:** Ensure blocks are correctly oriented and aligned before applying gentle, firm pressure. Avoid forcing blocks, as this can cause damage.
- **Model Instability:** Review the assembly steps to ensure all connections are secure and no blocks are misplaced. Incorrect placement can affect the model's structural integrity.
