1. IMPORTANT SAFETY INSTRUCTIONS

Please read this manual thoroughly before using the Polti Vaporetto Lecoaspira FAV30. Keep these instructions for future reference. Failure to follow these safety guidelines may result in electric shock, fire, or serious injury.

- Always ensure the appliance is unplugged before performing any maintenance or when not in use.
- Do not leave the appliance unattended while it is operating or connected to the power supply.
- Keep the appliance out of reach of children and individuals with reduced physical, sensory, or mental capabilities.
- Use only original Polti accessories and spare parts.
- Do not direct the steam jet at people, animals, or electrical appliances. Steam is very hot and can cause burns.
- Never immerse the appliance in water or other liquids.
- Do not open the safety cap while the appliance is under pressure. Allow it to cool down completely before refilling.
- Regularly check the power cord for damage. If damaged, it must be replaced by the manufacturer or a qualified service agent.

2. PRODUCT OVERVIEW

2.1 Main Unit

3. SETUP

3.1 Unpacking

Carefully remove all components from the packaging. Retain the packaging for potential future transport or storage. Ensure all listed accessories are present.

3.2 Filling the Water Tank (for Steam Function)

1. Unscrew the safety cap on the boiler.
2. Using the provided funnel, fill the boiler with approximately 1.8 liters of demineralized water. Using tap water can lead to limescale buildup.
3. Securely screw the safety cap back on.

3.3 Filling the Water Filter (for Vacuum Function)

1. Locate and remove the water filter tank.
2. Fill the tank with clean tap water up to the indicated maximum level (approximately 1.1 liters).
3. Reinsert the water filter tank into its designated compartment until it clicks into place.

3.4 Attaching Accessories

Connect the flexible hose to the main unit. Attach the desired accessory (e.g., floor brush, small brush, lance) to the end of the hose or extension tubes, ensuring a secure fit.

4. OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

4.1 Powering On

1. Plug the appliance into a suitable electrical outlet.
2. Press the main power switch. The indicator light will illuminate.
3. Allow approximately 11 minutes for the boiler to heat up and reach operating pressure. The steam ready indicator light will turn on when the appliance is ready for use.

4.2 Steam Cleaning Mode

The Polti Vaporetto Lecoaspira FAV30 generates high-pressure steam (4 bar) capable of eliminating 99.99% of viruses, germs, and bacteria from surfaces.

1. Select the desired steam intensity using the control dial on the handle.
2. Press the steam activation button on the handle to release steam.
3. Move the accessory slowly over the surface to be cleaned. For stubborn dirt, hold the steam jet over the area for a few seconds.

4.3 Vacuuming Mode

1. Ensure the water filter tank is correctly filled.
2. Press the vacuum activation button on the handle.
3. Move the vacuum accessory over the surface to be cleaned. The water filter system effectively traps dust and dirt, including liquids.

4.4 Combined Steam and Vacuum Mode

For deep cleaning and simultaneous drying, activate both the steam and vacuum functions. This mode is particularly effective for removing stubborn dirt and leaving surfaces clean and nearly dry.

5. MAINTENANCE

5.1 Emptying and Cleaning the Water Filter Tank

It is crucial to empty and clean the water filter tank after each use to prevent unpleasant odors and maintain

optimal performance.

1. Unplug the appliance and allow it to cool down.
2. Remove the water filter tank.
3. Carefully empty the dirty water and rinse the tank thoroughly with clean water.
4. Clean any debris from the filter components.
5. Allow the tank and components to air dry before reassembling.

5.2 Descaling the Boiler

Regular descaling is necessary to prevent limescale buildup, especially if demineralized water is not consistently used. Refer to the Polti website or contact customer support for recommended descaling procedures and products.

5.3 Cleaning Accessories

Wash all accessories with water and mild detergent as needed. Ensure they are completely dry before storing.

5.4 Storage

Store the appliance and its accessories in a dry, safe place, out of reach of children.

6. TROUBLESHOOTING

This section addresses common issues you might encounter with your Polti Vaporetto Lecoaspira FAV30.

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
No steam is produced.	Boiler is empty or not heated.	Check water level and ensure appliance has reached operating temperature.
Low steam pressure.	Limescale buildup in boiler.	Perform descaling procedure.
Vacuum suction is weak.	Water filter tank is full or dirty.	Empty and clean the water filter tank. Check for blockages in the hose or accessories.
Unpleasant odor during vacuuming.	Dirty water left in the filter tank.	Empty and thoroughly clean the water filter tank immediately after each use.
Appliance does not turn on.	No power supply.	Check power cord connection and wall outlet.
