Bovee WMA3000B Wireless Bluetooth Music Interface Adaptor User Manual

Model: WMA3000B

INTRODUCTION

The Bovee WMA3000B is a wireless Bluetooth music interface adaptor designed to integrate with your vehicle's existing iPod integration system (USB/AUX connector). This device allows you to wirelessly stream music from your Apple devices (iPhone, iPad, iPod) and other Bluetooth-enabled smartphones to your car's audio system, utilizing steering wheel controls for Apple devices where supported.

SETUP AND INSTALLATION

The Bovee WMA3000B is designed for plug-and-play installation, requiring no complex setup. Follow these steps to get started:

1. **Connect the Adaptor:** Simply plug the Bovee WMA3000B into your vehicle's USB/AUX iPod integration system. Ensure it is securely connected.
2. **Power On:** Once connected, the adaptor should power on automatically. Look for a blue light indicator on the device.
3. **Pair with Your Device:**
 - On your smartphone or Apple device, go to your Bluetooth settings.
 - Search for available Bluetooth devices.
 - Select "Bovee" or a similar name from the list.
 - If prompted for a pairing code, enter **0000**.
4. **Automatic Reconnection:** After initial pairing, the device will automatically reconnect to your phone every time you enter the vehicle, eliminating the need for manual re-connection.

Compatibility Note: This adaptor is specifically compatible with BMW USB/AUX iPod integration systems that are pre-installed and vehicles that already support controlling iPhone and iPod music from the steering wheel.

Installation and Troubleshooting Tips (Pair Code: 0000)

Blue light indicator does not come on at all when plugged in.

Unplug the cable from the car and plug it back in. If the unit never powers on either your cable may not be functioning properly. Alternatively if it is an older make model car that does not provide a correct power source you will need an additional 30pin to 30pin adapter to inject power. You can use the accessory sold by viseeoussa or the cable jive dockstutz +

Car will not recognize: phone is paired but will not play music.

1. Make sure the cars stereo is **switched to AUX or ipod** depending on your car and model. Check with our cars manual or manufacturer as it can sometimes require holding a pair of buttons or a less intuitive button such as CDC in some Mercedes models.
2. You will also need to ensure that you have **downloaded and saved to your phone at least one song** in your phone's native library. It is very **important** even if you wish to play media from a streaming service or another app that you have at least one song in your library for the system to initialize communication properly with your vehicles ipod integration system.
3. Update your phone to the latest version OS. **Delete and unpair the device** from your bluetooth devices and restart your phone after an update then reconnect again.

Cannot Pair with Phone.

Unplug from car and restart your phone. Turn off other bluetooth devices. Plug back into car. When the blue light power and pairing indicator turns on tap to pair on your phone (**Pairing Code: 0000**). In some vehicles the unit will lose power if not sufficiently connected and you will need to unplug the device, plug it back in, and try again until successful. You should not need to do this again after a correct initial setup.

Music Quality is not good or the music is skipping.

Unplug from car and delete and delete and unpair the device from your bluetooth devices and update your phone to the latest version OS. Restart your phone after the update then reconnect and pair again.

My device was working but stopped connecting with my phone.

1. Disconnect from car and unpair or forget the device from your bluetooth devices
2. Turn Off bluetooth on your phone and restart the phone
3. Go to bluetooth settings and make sure bluetooth is off
4. Plug into the car and turn on Bluetooth
5. Pair and connect to bluetooth device using code 0000

Phone Settings May be Needed for Androids

1. Go to your smart phones settings
2. Go to app settings or apps
3. Select your music streaming application and grant the app permission to phone & storage
4. Go to your music streaming application settings and enable Device Broadcast Status

OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

Once the Bovee WMA3000B is successfully paired, you can begin streaming music and controlling playback.

- **Music Streaming:** Play music from any streaming service or your device's local library. The audio will be transmitted wirelessly to your car's sound system.
- **Steering Wheel Controls:** For Apple devices (iPhone, iPad, iPod), you can browse, skip tracks, and control music playback directly using your vehicle's original steering wheel controls.
- **Car Display Integration:** The adaptor allows your car's display to read, show, and control your iPhone, iPad, or iPod music library wirelessly.
- **Universal Compatibility for Streaming:** While steering wheel controls and library support are primarily for Apple devices, music streaming is compatible with all Bluetooth-capable smartphones.

MAINTENANCE

The Bovee WMA3000B requires minimal maintenance. To ensure optimal performance and longevity:

- Keep the device clean and free from dust and debris. Use a soft, dry cloth for cleaning.
- Avoid exposing the adaptor to extreme temperatures, moisture, or direct sunlight for extended periods.
- Ensure the adaptor is securely plugged into the car's port to prevent accidental disconnections.

TROUBLESHOOTING

If you encounter issues with your Bovee WMA3000B, refer to the following troubleshooting tips:

Blue Light Indicator Does Not Come On

- Unplug the cable from the car and plug it back in firmly.
- If the unit still does not power on, your cable may not be functioning correctly.
- For older car models that do not provide sufficient power, an additional 30-pin to 30-pin adapter may be required to inject power. Accessories like those sold by VisseeOUSA or Cable Jive DockStubz+ can be used.

Car Recognizes Phone, But No Music Plays

1. Ensure your car's stereo is switched to **AUX** or **iPod** mode, depending on your car and model. Consult your car's manual, as some systems may require specific button combinations (e.g., CDC in some Mercedes models).
2. Verify that you have at least one song downloaded and saved to your phone's native music library. This is crucial for the system to initialize communication with your vehicle's iPod integration system, even if you primarily stream music.
3. Update your phone to the latest operating system (OS) version. After the update, delete and unpair the Bovee device from your phone's Bluetooth settings, restart your phone, and then reconnect.

Cannot Pair with Phone

- Unplug the Bovee adaptor from the car and restart your phone.
- Turn off any other Bluetooth devices that might interfere.

- Plug the adaptor back into the car. When the blue light power and pairing indicator turns on, tap to pair on your phone (Pairing Code: **0000**).
- In some vehicles, if the unit loses power due to insufficient connection, you may need to unplug and re-plug the device until a successful connection is established. This should not be necessary after a correct initial setup.

Music Quality is Poor or Music is Skipping

- Unplug the adaptor from the car.
- Delete and unpair the device from your phone's Bluetooth settings.
- Update your phone to the latest operating system (OS) version.
- Restart your phone after the update, then reconnect and pair the device again.

Device Was Working But Stopped Connecting

1. Disconnect the adaptor from the car.
2. On your phone, unpair or "forget" the Bovee device from your Bluetooth devices list.
3. Turn off Bluetooth on your phone and restart the phone.
4. Go to Bluetooth settings and ensure Bluetooth is off.
5. Plug the adaptor back into the car.
6. Turn on Bluetooth on your phone.
7. Pair and connect to the Bovee device using code**0000**.

Phone Settings for Android Devices

For Android users, specific app permissions may be required for optimal functionality:

1. Go to your smartphone's settings.
2. Navigate to "App settings" or "Apps."
3. Select your music streaming application (e.g., Spotify, Pandora).
4. Grant the app permissions for "Phone" and "Storage."
5. Within your music streaming application settings, enable "Device Broadcast Status."
