Summer Infant 2-in-1 Convertible Crib to Bedrail Instruction Manual

INTRODUCTION

The Summer Infant 2-in-1 Convertible Crib to Bedrail is designed to assist in the transition of a child from a crib to a toddler bed, and subsequently to an adult-sized bed. This versatile bedrail provides security and peace of mind during these important developmental stages. It features an additional anchor to accommodate installation on twin or queen-sized mattresses. The bedrail can be folded down for convenient access to the bed or for changing linens. Assembly is minimal and does not require any tools.

SAFETY INFORMATION

Please read and understand all instructions before assembly and use of this product. Failure to follow these instructions could result in serious injury or death.

- This bedrail meets current ASTM F2085 standards.
- When used with a crib, the crib rail attaches securely to the crib's frame, not just the mattress, for enhanced stability.
- Ensure all components are correctly assembled and securely fastened before each use.
- Regularly check the bedrail for any signs of wear, damage, or loose parts. Discontinue use if any issues are found.
- Keep small parts away from children during assembly to prevent choking hazards.
- Do not use this bedrail on bunk beds, waterbeds, or beds with inflatable mattresses.

PACKAGE CONTENTS

Verify that all components are present before beginning assembly:

- 1 x Summer Infant 2-in-1 Convertible Crib to Bedrail unit
- 1 x Additional security anchor (for full/queen mattresses)

SETUP AND ASSEMBLY

The Summer Infant 2-in-1 Convertible Crib to Bedrail requires minimal assembly and no tools. Follow these steps for proper installation:

Crib Mode Installation

1. Position the bedrail against the side of the crib mattress.
2. Secure the bedrail's attachment arms to the crib frame. Ensure the rail is firmly attached and cannot be easily dislodged.
3. Verify that the bedrail is upright and locked into position.

Toddler/Adult Bed Mode Installation

1. Place the bedrail on the mattress of the toddler, twin, full, or queen-sized bed.
2. For full or queen mattresses, utilize the additional security anchor provided. Thread the anchor strap under the mattress and secure it to the opposite side of the bed frame or mattress.
3. Ensure the bedrail is positioned correctly and the anchor is taut, preventing movement.
4. Confirm the bedrail is upright and locked into position.

OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

Folding Down the Bedrail

The bedrail is designed to fold down for easy access to the bed or for changing linens. Locate the release mechanisms on both sides of the bedrail. Simultaneously press or slide these mechanisms to disengage the lock, then gently lower the bedrail until it lies flat against the side of the bed.

Raising the Bedrail

To raise the bedrail, lift it upwards until you hear an audible click, indicating that both sides have locked securely into the upright position. Always ensure the bedrail is fully locked before leaving your child unattended.

MAINTENANCE

To maintain the cleanliness and longevity of your Summer Infant 2-in-1 Convertible Crib to Bedrail:

- **Cleaning:** Wipe the bedrail with a damp cloth and mild soap. Allow it to air dry completely before re-use.
- **Inspection:** Periodically inspect the fabric, mesh, and frame for any tears, fraying, or damage. Check all connection points and locking mechanisms for proper function.
- **Storage:** If storing the bedrail, ensure it is clean and dry. Store in a cool, dry place away from direct sunlight.

TROUBLESHOOTING

If you encounter any issues with your bedrail, consider the following:

- **Bedrail not locking securely:** Ensure that both release mechanisms are fully disengaged when raising the rail and that you hear a distinct 'click' on both sides. Check for any obstructions preventing the locking pins from engaging.
- **Bedrail difficult to fold down:** Apply even pressure to both release mechanisms simultaneously. If the mechanism feels stiff, ensure no fabric is caught in the hinge. Avoid forcing the mechanism.
- **Bedrail feels loose after installation:** Re-check all attachment points to the crib frame or the security anchor under the mattress. Ensure the anchor strap is pulled taut and securely fastened. The bedrail should not have excessive movement.
- **Fabric cover issues:** If the fabric cover is difficult to zip or appears too tight, ensure it is correctly aligned with the frame. Gently work the zipper, avoiding excessive force.
