SETUP GUIDE

1. Initial Setup

Upon receiving your Nintendo 3DS, ensure all components are present: the Nintendo 3DS console, AC adapter, stylus, and any included documentation. Before first use, it is recommended to fully charge the device.



2. Charging the Console

To charge your Nintendo 3DS, connect the AC adapter to the charging port located on the back of the console. Plug the other end of the AC adapter into a standard wall outlet. The charging indicator light will illuminate, typically orange, to show that the console is charging. A full charge is indicated when the light turns off.

OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

1. Powering On/Off

To power on the console, press the **POWER** button located on the bottom right of the console. To power off, hold the **POWER** button until the system shuts down.

2. Basic Controls

- Circle Pad: Used for analog movement in games.
- Directional Pad (D-Pad): Used for directional input, menu navigation.
- A/B/X/Y Buttons: Action buttons for gameplay and menu selection.
- L/R Buttons: Shoulder buttons, often used for specific in-game actions.
- **Touch Screen:** The bottom screen is a touch screen, operable with the included stylus or your finger.
- **3D Slider:** Located on the right side of the top screen, this slider adjusts the intensity of the 3D effect or turns it off.

3. Playing Games

Insert a Nintendo 3DS game card into the game card slot on the back of the console. The game icon will appear on the Home Menu. Tap the icon to start the game. For digital titles, select the game from the Home Menu.

4. Using the Camera

The Nintendo 3DS features two outer cameras for 3D photos and videos, and one inner camera for 2D photos. Access the Camera application from the Home Menu to take pictures or record videos. The stylus can be used to tap on-screen controls.

MAINTENANCE

1. Cleaning the Console

To clean the Nintendo 3DS, use a soft, dry cloth. For stubborn smudges on the screens, a slightly damp, lint-free cloth can be used. Avoid using harsh chemicals or abrasive materials, as these can damage the console's finish or screens.

2. Storage

Store the console in a cool, dry place away from direct sunlight and extreme temperatures. When not in use, close the console to protect the screens. It is advisable to store it in a protective case to prevent scratches and impacts.

TROUBLESHOOTING

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Console does not power on.	Low battery or power issue.	Ensure the console is fully charged. Check the AC adapter connection.
Game card not recognized.	Improperly inserted game card or dirty contacts.	Remove and reinsert the game card firmly. Clean the game card contacts with a soft cloth.
3D effect is blurry or causes discomfort.	Incorrect viewing angle or 3D slider setting.	Adjust the 3D slider to a comfortable level or turn it off. Ensure you are holding the console at the correct viewing distance and angle.
