INTRODUCTION

This manual provides instructions for the installation, operation, maintenance, and troubleshooting of your Moen Engage Spot Resist Brushed Nickel Six-Function 5.5-Inch Removable Handheld Showerhead with Magnetic Docking System, model 26112SRN. Please read these instructions carefully before installation and use to ensure proper function and longevity of your product.

PRODUCT FEATURES

- **Six-Function Spray Settings:** Customize your shower experience with multiple distinct settings including massage, relaxing massage, wide-coverage, rinse, downpour, and intensify.
- **Magnetic Docking System:** The Magnetix docking system allows for easy, one-handed release and secure reattachment of the handheld showerhead. The showerhead always docks forward to prevent water from splashing outside the shower area.
- **Spot Resist Finish:** The Spot Resist Brushed Nickel finish resists fingerprints and water spots, contributing to a cleaner appearance.

- **Flexible Hose:** Includes a 60-inch kink-free metal hose for extended reach and flexibility, useful for rinsing, cleaning, and bathing.
- **Easy Installation:** Designed for direct installation onto existing shower arms, suitable for most standard setups.

PACKAGE CONTENTS

Verify that all components are present before beginning installation:

- Handheld Showerhead
- 60-inch Metal Hose
- Magnetic Docking Bracket
- Washers (3, 1 pre-installed)




Image: A diagram illustrating the six distinct spray patterns available and the components included in the package: the handshower, 60-inch metal hose, magnetic dock, and three washers.

SETUP AND INSTALLATION

1. **Preparation:** Ensure the water supply to your shower is turned off. Remove your existing showerhead by unscrewing it counter-clockwise from the shower arm. Clean any old sealant or tape from the shower arm threads.
2. **Apply Plumber's Tape:** Wrap plumber's tape (thread seal tape) clockwise around the threads of your shower arm 3-4 times. This helps prevent leaks.
3. **Install Magnetic Docking Bracket:** Screw the new magnetic docking bracket onto the shower arm threads clockwise. Hand-tighten first, then use a wrench to tighten an additional 1/4 to 1/2 turn. Do not overtighten.




Image: A person's hands applying plumber's tape to the threaded end of a shower arm, preparing for the installation of the new showerhead.

4. **Connect Hose to Bracket:** Ensure a washer is inside the conical nut of the 60-inch metal hose. Screw this end onto the magnetic docking bracket. Hand-tighten securely.
5. **Connect Hose to Handheld Showerhead:** Ensure a washer is inside the hexagonal nut of the 60-inch metal hose. Screw this end onto the handheld showerhead. Hand-tighten securely.
6. **Test for Leaks:** Turn on the water supply and check all connections for leaks. If leaks occur, tighten the connections slightly.

OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

Using the Magnetic Docking System

The Magnetix system allows for easy detachment and reattachment of the handheld showerhead. Simply pull the showerhead away from the magnetic dock to remove it. To reattach, guide the showerhead close to the dock, and the magnet will securely pull it into place, ensuring it always faces forward.




Image: A diagram highlighting the Magnetix docking technology, showing how the handheld showerhead easily releases and securely snaps back into place on its magnetic mount.

Adjusting Spray Settings

Your Moen Engage showerhead features six distinct spray functions. To change the spray pattern, locate the button or lever on the showerhead face or handle and press or slide it to cycle through the available settings:

- Massage
- Relaxing Massage
- Wide Coverage
- Rinse
- Downpour
- Intensify




Cleaning the Finish

The Spot Resist Brushed Nickel finish is designed to resist fingerprints and water spots. To maintain its appearance, clean regularly with a soft, damp cloth. Avoid abrasive cleaners, harsh chemicals, or scrubbing pads, as these can damage the finish and void your warranty.









Cleaning Nozzles

Over time, mineral deposits can accumulate in the spray nozzles, affecting water flow. To clean, gently rub the rubber nozzles with your finger or a soft brush while water is flowing. For stubborn deposits, a solution of equal parts white vinegar and water can be applied to the nozzles for a short period before rinsing thoroughly.

TROUBLESHOOTING

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
---------	----------------	----------

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Low Water Pressure	Clogged nozzles or mineral buildup.	Clean the spray nozzles as described in the Maintenance section. Ensure water supply valves are fully open.
Leaks at Connections	Loose connections or insufficient plumber's tape.	Tighten all connections. If leaks persist, disassemble, reapply plumber's tape, and reassemble. Ensure washers are properly seated.
Showerhead Does Not Dock Securely	Obstruction on magnetic surface or improper alignment.	Ensure the magnetic surfaces on both the showerhead and the dock are clean and free of debris. Verify the showerhead is aligned correctly with the dock.
Difficulty Changing Spray Settings	Mineral buildup in the selector mechanism.	Run hot water through the showerhead to help dislodge mineral deposits. If necessary, soak the showerhead in a vinegar solution (refer to nozzle cleaning).
