1. Introduction

Thank you for choosing the ORAVA VK-3217 Y Kettle. This manual provides essential information for the safe and efficient use of your new appliance. Please read these instructions carefully before first use and keep them for future reference.

The ORAVA VK-3217 Y is a stainless steel kettle designed for quick and efficient water boiling. It features a 1.7-liter capacity and a powerful 2000-watt heating element. Key features include a removable filter, a 360° swivel base, and an automatic shut-off function for safety.

2. Safety Instructions

- Read all instructions before using the appliance.
- Do not immerse the kettle, power base, cord, or plug in water or any other liquid.
- This appliance is for household use only. Do not use outdoors.
- Ensure the voltage indicated on the appliance corresponds to your local mains voltage before connecting.
- Always place the kettle on a firm, flat, heat-resistant surface.
- Do not operate the kettle if the cord or plug is damaged, or if the appliance malfunctions or has been damaged in any way.
- · Keep the appliance and its cord out of reach of children.
- Do not fill above the maximum level indicator to prevent boiling water from overflowing.
- Always ensure the lid is securely closed before operating.
- The kettle will automatically switch off once the water has boiled. Do not attempt to override this mechanism.
- Unplug the kettle from the outlet when not in use and before cleaning.

3. Product Overview

Familiarize yourself with the components of your ORAVA VK-3217 Y Kettle:

- Spout
- Lid (with opening mechanism)
- Handle
- Power Switch / Indicator Light
- Water Level Indicator (internal)
- Removable Filter
- Power Base (360° swivel)
- Cord Storage (under base)

4. Setup

- 1. Unpack the kettle and all accessories. Remove any packaging materials.
- 2. Before first use, fill the kettle with clean water to the maximum level.
- 3. Boil the water (refer to Operating Instructions).
- 4. Discard the boiled water. Repeat this process once or twice to remove any manufacturing residues.
- 5. Place the power base on a stable, flat, and dry surface.
- 6. Ensure the power cord is fully unwound and plugged into a suitable wall outlet.

5. Operating Instructions

- Fill the Kettle: Press the visible light signal button on the lid and rotate to open. Fill the kettle with the
 desired amount of fresh water, ensuring it is between the minimum and maximum fill lines. Do not
 overfill.
- 2. Close the Lid: Close the lid securely until it clicks into place.
- 3. **Place on Base:** Position the kettle onto the power base. The kettle can be placed in any direction on the 360° swivel base.
- 4. **Switch On:** Press the power switch located on the handle downwards. The indicator light will illuminate, signaling that the kettle is heating.
- 5. **Automatic Shut-off:** The kettle will automatically switch off once the water has reached boiling point. The indicator light will turn off.
- 6. **Pour Water:** Carefully lift the kettle from its base and pour the hot water. Be cautious of steam escaping from the spout.
- 7. **Re-boil:** If you need to boil water again, wait a few moments for the automatic shut-off mechanism to reset before pressing the power switch.

6. Maintenance and Cleaning

Regular cleaning and maintenance will prolong the life of your kettle.

- Before Cleaning: Always unplug the kettle from the power outlet and allow it to cool completely before cleaning.
- Exterior Cleaning: Wipe the exterior of the kettle with a soft, damp cloth. Do not use abrasive cleaners or scouring pads, as these can damage the finish.
- Interior Cleaning / Descaling: Over time, mineral deposits (limescale) may build up inside the kettle, especially in hard water areas. To descale, fill the kettle with a mixture of water and white vinegar (e.g., 1 part vinegar to 2 parts water) or a commercial descaling solution. Boil the mixture and let it stand for at least 30 minutes, or longer for heavy deposits. Empty the kettle and rinse thoroughly with fresh water several times.
- Removable Filter: The kettle features a removable filter. To clean, remove it from the spout and
 rinse under running water. Use a soft brush if necessary to remove any deposits. Reinsert the filter
 securely after cleaning.
- **Storage:** When not in use, the power cord can be conveniently stored in the base. Store the kettle in a dry place.

7. Troubleshooting

If you encounter any issues with your kettle, please refer to the following common problems and solutions:

· Kettle does not turn on:

- Check if the kettle is properly plugged into a working power outlet.
- Ensure the kettle is correctly seated on its power base.
- Verify that the power switch is pressed down.

· Water is not boiling:

- Confirm the power switch is engaged and the indicator light is on.
- Check for limescale buildup, which can affect heating efficiency. Descale if necessary.

· Kettle switches off too quickly or not at all:

- Ensure the lid is fully closed.
- Excessive limescale can interfere with the automatic shut-off mechanism. Descale the kettle.
- If the issue persists, discontinue use and contact customer support.

· Water tastes unusual:

- For first-time use, ensure you have performed the initial cleaning steps (boiling and discarding water).
- Descale the kettle regularly to prevent mineral taste.
