## SAFETY INFORMATION

 Always unplug the machine from the electrical outlet when cleaning, lubricating, or when the machine is not in use.

- Do not operate the machine with a damaged cord or plug. If the machine is not working properly, has been dropped or damaged, or dropped into water, return it to the nearest authorized service dealer for examination and repair.
- Keep fingers away from all moving parts. Special care is required around the sewing machine needle.
- Always use the proper needle plate. The wrong plate can cause the needle to break.
- Do not pull or push fabric while stitching. This may deflect the needle causing it to break.
- Turn the sewing machine off when making any adjustments in the needle area, such as threading the needle, changing the needle, threading the bobbin, or changing the presser foot.

#### PRODUCT OVERVIEW

The Singer 212-214 is a versatile sewing machine designed for a range of sewing, embroidery, and serging tasks. Its robust construction and intuitive design make it suitable for both experienced users and those new to advanced sewing techniques.

# SETUP

## **Unpacking:**

- 1. Carefully remove the machine from its packaging.
- 2. Remove all packing materials, including any protective films or tapes.
- 3. Retain the original packaging for future transport or storage.

#### **Power Connection:**

- 1. Place the machine on a stable, flat surface.
- 2. Ensure the power switch is in the 'OFF' position.
- 3. Connect the power cord to the machine's power input and then to a suitable electrical outlet.

## **Initial Threading:**

- 1. Raise the presser foot lever.
- 2. Follow the numbered threading path indicated on the machine for the upper thread.
- 3. Insert a wound bobbin into the bobbin case according to the diagram in the manual.
- 4. Pull the bobbin thread up through the needle plate opening.

# **OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS**

# **Basic Operation:**

- 1. Turn the power switch to 'ON'.
- 2. Select your desired stitch pattern using the stitch selector dial.
- 3. Adjust stitch length and width as needed for your fabric and project.
- 4. Place fabric under the presser foot and lower the presser foot lever.
- 5. Gently press the foot controller to begin sewing.

#### **Stitch Selection:**

The Singer 212-214 offers a variety of stitch patterns. Refer to the stitch chart on your machine or in the full manual for specific applications of each stitch, including straight stitch, zigzag, buttonhole, and decorative stitches.

# **Fabric Handling:**

Always guide the fabric gently. Do not pull or push the fabric, as this can bend the needle and affect stitch quality. Allow the machine's feed dogs to move the fabric at a consistent pace.

#### MAINTENANCE

# Cleaning:

- · Unplug the machine before cleaning.
- · Regularly remove lint and dust from the bobbin case area and feed dogs using a small brush.
- Wipe the exterior surfaces with a soft, dry cloth. Do not use harsh chemicals.

#### **Lubrication:**

Refer to the full manual for specific lubrication points and recommended oil types. Generally, a few drops of high-quality sewing machine oil should be applied to moving metal parts every few months, depending on usage.

## **Needle Replacement:**

- 1. Turn off the machine and raise the needle to its highest position.
- 2. Loosen the needle clamp screw.
- 3. Remove the old needle and insert a new needle with the flat side facing the back of the machine.
- 4. Tighten the needle clamp screw securely.

#### **TROUBLESHOOTING**

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution	
Skipped Stitches	Incorrect needle, bent needle, improper threading.	Change needle, re-thread machine correctly.	
Thread Breaking	Incorrect tension, poor quality thread, burr on needle plate.	Adjust tension, use quality thread, check for burrs.	

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution	
Machine Not Feeding Fabric	Feed dogs lowered, lint accumulation.	Raise feed dogs, clean feed dog area.	
No Power	Power cord not plugged in, power switch off.	Check power connections, turn power switch on.
