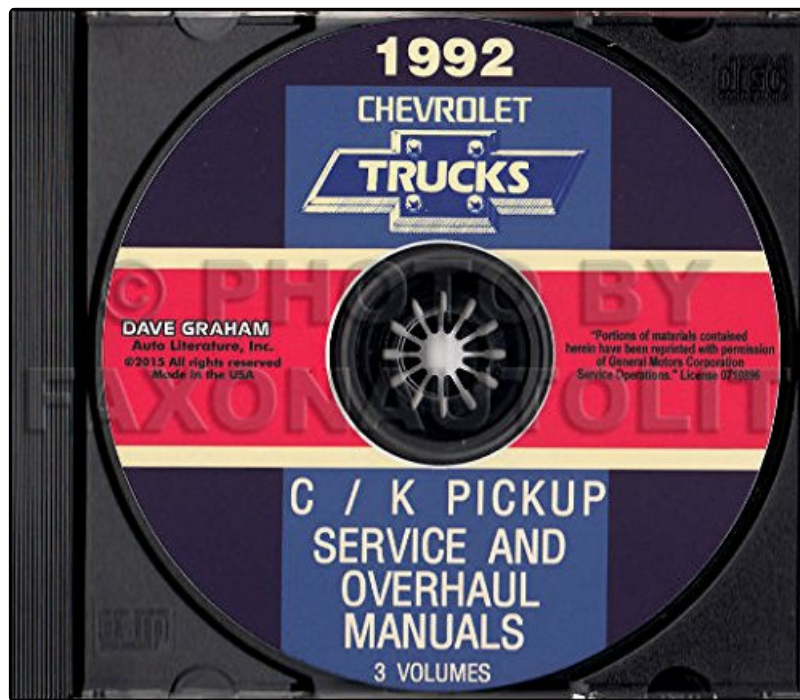


Image: Cover of the 1992 Chevrolet Truck & Pickup Service Manual CD-ROM, showing the product packaging.

SETUP

1. **System Requirements:** Ensure your computer has a CD-ROM drive and a compatible operating system (e.g., Windows XP, Vista, 7, 8, 10, or macOS with appropriate compatibility software). MAINTENANCE

TROUBLESHOOTING
