Introduction

This manual provides essential instructions for the proper use and care of your Orient Standard Neo 70's Solar Grey WV0061SE watch. This timepiece combines a classic 70s-inspired design with modern solar-powered and radio-controlled technology, ensuring accurate timekeeping without the need for battery changes or manual time adjustments.

SETUP

1. Initial Charging

Your watch is powered by light. Before initial use, expose the watch dial to bright light (natural sunlight is ideal) for several hours to ensure it is sufficiently charged. Avoid placing the watch in direct sunlight for extended periods in extremely hot environments to prevent damage.

2. Radio Signal Reception

The WV0061SE is a radio-controlled watch, meaning it automatically synchronizes with an atomic clock signal to maintain accurate time. For optimal reception:

- Place the watch near a window, away from electronic devices that may cause interference.
- Ensure the watch is not covered or obstructed.
- The watch typically attempts to receive a signal overnight. If reception is successful, the time and date will be automatically adjusted.

If the watch does not receive a signal, it will operate as a standard quartz watch, maintaining accuracy based on its internal oscillator.

3. Manual Time/Date Adjustment (If necessary)

Refer to the detailed instructions in the included user manual for specific steps on manually setting the time and date, or for initiating a manual radio signal reception attempt. This typically involves pulling out the crown and/or using the pushers.

OPERATING THE WATCH

Time Display

The watch displays hours, minutes, and seconds using three central hands. The hour and minute hands are luminous for visibility in low light conditions.

Date Display

A date window is located at the 3 o'clock position, displaying the current day of the month.

MAINTENANCE

Cleaning

Wipe the watch case and bracelet regularly with a soft, dry cloth to remove dirt and perspiration. For stubborn dirt, a slightly damp cloth can be used, followed by a dry cloth. Avoid using chemical cleaners or abrasive materials.

Water Resistance

This watch features 10 bar (100 meters) water resistance, making it suitable for daily use, showering, and swimming. However, it is **not** suitable for diving. Ensure the crown is pushed in completely before exposing the watch to water. Do not operate the crown or pushers while the watch is wet.

Solar Charging

To maintain optimal performance, ensure the watch is regularly exposed to light. If stored in darkness for extended periods, the power reserve may deplete, requiring a full recharge. The watch has a power-saving function that activates when it is left in darkness.

TROUBLESHOOTING

- Watch not running: Ensure the watch has been sufficiently charged by exposing it to bright light for several hours.
- Incorrect time/date: Check if the watch is receiving the radio signal. Try placing it near a window overnight. If issues persist, refer to the full manual for manual adjustment procedures.
- Hands not moving smoothly: This could indicate a low power reserve. Charge the watch fully. If the problem continues, professional service may be required.
