1. Introduction

The Elgato HD60 Pro is an internal PCIe capture card designed for high-quality gameplay capture and streaming. This device allows users to record and stream console gameplay in 1080p resolution at 60 frames per second (1080p60) with ultra-low-latency passthrough. It integrates directly into your PC, providing a dedicated hardware encoder for efficient performance.

3. SETUP GUIDE

3.1. Physical Installation

- 1. Prepare your PC: Power down your computer and unplug all cables. Open your PC case.
- 2. Locate a PCle slot: Find an available PCle x1 slot on your motherboard.
- 3. **Insert the HD60 Pro:** Carefully align the HD60 Pro card with the PCIe slot and firmly press it down until it is securely seated.
- 4. Secure the card: Use a screw to fasten the HD60 Pro bracket to your PC case.
- 5. Close PC case: Reattach your PC case cover and reconnect all cables.

3.2. Software Installation

- 1. **Download Software:** Visit the official Elgato website (elgato.com/download) to download the latest Elgato Game Capture HD software and drivers for your operating system (Windows or macOS).
- 2. Install Software: Follow the on-screen instructions to install the software.
- 3. **Alternative Software:** The HD60 Pro is compatible with popular streaming software such as OBS Studio, Streamlabs OBS, and XSplit.

3.3. Connecting Devices

- 1. **HDMI In:** Connect an HDMI cable from your gaming console's HDMI output (e.g., PS5, PS4, Xbox Series X/S, Xbox One) to the **HDMI IN** port on the Elgato HD60 Pro.
- 2. **HDMI Out:** Connect another HDMI cable from the **HDMI OUT** port on the Elgato HD60 Pro to your TV or gaming monitor's HDMI input. This provides zero-lag passthrough for your gameplay.

- 4. Start Recording: Click the record button within the software to begin capturing your gameplay.

4.2. Instant Gameview and Passthrough

The HD60 Pro features Instant Gameview, providing ultra-low-latency passthrough directly to your TV or monitor. This allows you to play your games without any noticeable delay, ensuring a seamless gaming experience while simultaneously capturing footage on your PC.




Image: The Instant Gameview feature of the Elgato HD60 Pro ensures ultra-low latency for real-time broadcasting and gaming.

6. TROUBLESHOOTING

• No Signal/Black Screen:

- Verify all HDMI cables are securely connected to the correct IN/OUT ports.
- Ensure your gaming console's HDCP (High-bandwidth Digital Content Protection) is disabled.
 Refer to your console's settings for instructions.
- Check your software settings to ensure the HD60 Pro is selected as the input device and the resolution/frame rate are correctly configured.

· Audio Issues:

- Confirm audio input/output settings within your capture software.
- Ensure any external audio devices (headsets, microphones) are properly connected and selected.

• Performance/Lag:

- Ensure your PC meets the minimum system requirements for the HD60 Pro and your chosen capture software.
- Update your graphics card drivers and Elgato software to the latest versions.
- Close unnecessary background applications to free up system resources.
