


Figure 1: FRIGIDAIRE 5303918277 Ice Maker Replacement unit, showing the main body, ice mold, and electrical connector.

#### 3. OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

The ice maker operates automatically once properly installed and the freezer reaches its operating temperature. It will fill with water, freeze the water into cubes, and then eject them into the ice bin.

#### On/Off Control:

Most ice makers feature a wire shut-off arm. When this arm is in the down position, the ice maker is **ON** and will produce ice. When the ice bin is full, the arm will be pushed up by the ice, automatically stopping ice production. To manually stop ice production, lift the wire arm to the up position.

# **Ice Production Cycle:**

The ice maker typically produces a batch of ice every few hours, depending on freezer temperature and usage. The first few batches of ice may be smaller or have an unusual taste; it is recommended to discard these initial batches.

#### 4. MAINTENANCE

- Wipe down the exterior of the ice maker unit with a damp cloth. Avoid using abrasive cleaners or solvents.

#### Water Filter:

If your refrigerator has a water filter, ensure it is replaced according to the manufacturer's recommendations to maintain water quality and ice production efficiency.

#### 5. TROUBLESHOOTING

If your ice maker is not functioning as expected, consider the following common issues and solutions:

Ice maker is noisy	<ul><li>Normal operation sounds (filling, ejecting ice).</li><li>Loose components.</li></ul>	<ul> <li>Some noise is normal during the ice-making cycle.</li> <li>Ensure the ice maker is securely mounted.</li> </ul>
Ice maker does not turn off	<ul><li>Wire shut-off arm is stuck or obstructed.</li><li>Faulty control mechanism.</li></ul>	<ul> <li>Check for ice or other obstructions preventing the arm from moving freely.</li> <li>If the issue persists, contact a qualified service technician.</li> </ul>

If troubleshooting steps do not resolve the issue, it is recommended to contact a qualified appliance technician for further assistance.
