### Introduction

The Pyle PWMA230BT is a versatile wireless portable PA loudspeaker system designed for various audio applications. It offers wireless freedom with built-in Bluetooth and a rechargeable battery, along with multiple input options for microphones, instruments, and external devices. Its portable design, featuring a telescoping handle and rolling caster wheels, ensures easy transport for events, gatherings, or personal use.

- 400 Watt Peak Power Output (200 Watts RMS) with 8" Woofer.
- Bluetooth Compatible for Wireless Audio Streaming.
- Built-in Rechargeable Lead Acid Battery (12V 7Ah) for up to 10 hours of use.

## Control Panel Features:

- **MP3 Control Digital Display:** Shows current mode (Bluetooth, FM, Line In) and track information.
- **Bluetooth (BT) Button:** Activates Bluetooth pairing mode.
- **Mode Button:** Switches between Bluetooth, FM Radio, and Line In modes.
- **Volume Knobs:** Independent controls for microphone volume, guitar volume, audio input volume, echo, treble, and bass.
- **Microphone Inputs (MIC1, MIC2):** 1/4" jacks for wired microphones.
- **Guitar/Instrument Inputs:** 1/4" jacks for connecting guitars or other instruments.
- **Audio In (AUX, RCA):** Connect external audio sources via 3.5mm AUX or RCA cables.
- **Audio Out (RCA):** Connect to another PA system or recording device.
- **USB/SD Card Readers:** For playing MP3 files directly from storage devices.
- **Power Switch:** Turns the unit ON/OFF.
- **DC 12V Input:** For external 12V power source.
- **Battery Level Indicator:** LED lights show remaining battery charge.

## Setup

## Initial Charging

Before first use, fully charge the internal rechargeable battery. Connect the provided power cable to the AC IN port on the unit and plug it into a standard wall outlet. The 'CHARGE' indicator light will illuminate. A full charge typically takes 8-10 hours. The battery level indicator LEDs will show charging progress.

## Powering On/Off

To power on the unit, slide the POWER switch to the 'ON' position. To power off, slide the switch to 'OFF'.

## Microphone Setup

The system includes a wireless dynamic microphone. Insert 2 'AA' batteries (not included) into the wireless microphone. Turn on the microphone and ensure the wireless microphone volume is adjusted on the main unit. For optimal reception, extend the antenna on the PA system.

## Operating

### Bluetooth Connectivity

To connect your Bluetooth-enabled device (smartphone, tablet, or computer) to the PWMA230BT:

1. Press the 'BT' button on the control panel to enter Bluetooth pairing mode. The digital display will show 'BLUE'.
2. On your device, search for Bluetooth networks and select 'Pyle Speaker'.
3. Once successfully connected, audio will stream wirelessly from your device to the PA system.

## Using Multiple Inputs

The PWMA230BT supports simultaneous use of multiple audio sources:

- **Microphones:** Connect up to two wired 1/4" microphones to the MIC1 and MIC2 inputs. Adjust individual microphone volumes using the 'W/MIC1.VOL' and 'MIC2.VOL' knobs.
- **Guitar/Instruments:** Connect instruments to the 'GUITAR' inputs. Adjust volume with the 'GT.VOL' knob.
- **External Audio:** Use the 'AUDIO.IN' (3.5mm AUX or RCA) inputs to connect devices like MP3 players or laptops. Adjust volume with the 'AUDIO.VOL' knob.
- **USB/SD Playback:** Insert a USB flash drive or SD card into the respective slots. The system will automatically play compatible audio files. Use the MP3 control buttons for playback navigation.

## Maintenance

- Battery Care:** To prolong battery life, avoid completely draining the battery. Recharge the unit after each use. If storing for extended periods, charge the battery every 3-6 months.
- Cleaning:** Use a soft, dry cloth to clean the exterior of the unit. Avoid using harsh chemicals or abrasive cleaners.
- Storage:** Store the unit in a cool, dry place away from direct sunlight and extreme temperatures.

## Troubleshooting

- No Power:** Ensure the power cable is securely connected and the unit is switched ON. Check if the battery is charged.

- **No Sound:** Verify that the volume levels for the main unit, microphones, and connected devices are turned up. Ensure the correct input mode (Bluetooth, AUX, etc.) is selected.
- **Bluetooth Connection Issues:** Ensure Bluetooth is enabled on your device and the PA system is in pairing mode. Disconnect and reconnect if issues persist. Move closer to the unit to reduce interference.
- **Microphone Not Working:** Check microphone batteries and ensure the microphone is turned ON. Adjust microphone volume on the PA system.
- **Distorted Sound:** Reduce volume levels to prevent distortion. Check audio cables for damage.
